18\_JOB\_05\_01 Call now, if there be any that will answer thee; and to which of the saints wilt thou turn?

18\_JOB\_05\_02 For wrath killeth the foolish man, and envy slayeth the silly one.

18\_JOB\_05\_03 I have seen the foolish taking root: but suddenly I cursed his habitation.

 $18\_JOB\_05\_04 \ His \ children \ are \ far \ from \ safety, \ and \ they \ are \ crushed \ in \ the \ gate, neither \ [is \ there] \ any \ to \ deliver \ [them].$ 

18\_JOB\_05\_05 Whose harvest the hungry eateth up, and taketh it even out of the thorns, and the robber swalloweth up their substance.

18\_JOB\_05\_06 Although affliction cometh not forth of the dust, neither doth trouble spring out of the ground;

18\_JOB\_05\_07 Yet man is born unto trouble, as the sparks fly upward.

18\_JOB\_05\_08 I would seek unto God, and unto God would I commit my cause:

18\_JOB\_05\_09 Which doeth great things and unsearchable; marvellous things without number:

18\_JOB\_05\_10 Who giveth rain upon the earth, and sendeth waters upon the fields:

18 JOB 05 11 To set up on high those that be low; that those which mourn may be exalted to safety.

18\_JOB\_05\_12 He disappointeth the devices of the crafty, so that their hands cannot perform [their] enterprise.

 $18\_JOB\_05\_13$  He taketh the wise in their own craftiness: and the counsel of the froward is carried headlong.

18\_JOB\_05\_14 They meet with darkness in the daytime, and grope in the noonday as in the night.

18\_JOB\_05\_15 But he saveth the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty.

18\_JOB\_05\_16 So the poor hath hope, and iniquity stoppeth her mouth.

18\_JOB\_05\_17 Behold, happy [is] the man whom God correcteth: therefore despise not thou the chastening of the Almighty:

18\_JOB\_05\_18 For he maketh sore, and bindeth up: he woundeth, and his hands make whole.

18\_JOB\_05\_19 He shall deliver thee in six troubles: yea, in seven there shall no evil touch thee.

18\_JOB\_05\_20 In famine he shall redeem thee from death: and in war from the power of the sword.

18\_JOB\_05\_21 Thou shalt be hid from the scourge of the tongue: neither shalt thou be afraid of destruction when it cometh.

18\_JOB\_05\_22 At destruction and famine thou shalt laugh: neither shalt thou be afraid of the beasts of the earth.

18\_JOB\_05\_23 For thou shalt be in league with the stones of the field: and the beasts of the field shall be at peace with thee.

18\_JOB\_05\_24 And thou shalt know that thy tabernacle [shall be] in peace; and thou shalt visit thy habitation, and shalt not sin.

 $18\_JOB\_05\_25\ Thou\ shalt\ know\ also\ that\ thy\ seed\ [shall\ be]\ great,\ and\ thine\ offspring\ as\ the\ grass\ of\ the\ earth.$ 

18\_JOB\_05\_26 Thou shalt come to [thy] grave in a full age, like as a shock of corn cometh in in his season.

18\_JOB\_05\_27 Lo this, we have searched it, so it [is]; hear it, and know thou [it] for thy good.
