

## Book of Job Chapter 08

18\_JOB\_08\_01 Then answered Bildad the Shuhite, and said,

18\_JOB\_08\_02 How long wilt thou speak these [things]? and [how long shall] the words of thy mouth [be like] a strong wind?

18\_JOB\_08\_03 Doth God pervert judgment? or doth the Almighty pervert justice?

18\_JOB\_08\_04 If thy children have sinned against him, and he have cast them away for their transgression;

18\_JOB\_08\_05 If thou wouldest seek unto God betimes, and make thy supplication to the Almighty;

18\_JOB\_08\_06 If thou [wert] pure and upright; surely now he would awake for thee, and make the habitation of thy righteousness prosperous.

18\_JOB\_08\_07 Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.

18\_JOB\_08\_08 For inquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers:

18\_JOB\_08\_09 [For we [are but of] yesterday, and know nothing, because our days upon earth [are] a shadow:]

18\_JOB\_08\_10 Shall not they teach thee, [and] tell thee, and utter words out of their heart?

18\_JOB\_08\_11 Can the rush grow up without mire? can the flag grow without water?

18\_JOB\_08\_12 Whilst it [is] yet in his greenness, [and] not cut down, it withereth before any [other] herb.

18\_JOB\_08\_13 So [are] the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's hope shall perish:

18\_JOB\_08\_14 Whose hope shall be cut off, and whose trust [shall be] a spider's web.

18\_JOB\_08\_15 He shall lean upon his house, but it shall not stand: he shall hold it fast, but it shall not endure.

18\_JOB\_08\_16 He [is] green before the sun, and his branch shooteth forth in his garden.

18\_JOB\_08\_17 His roots are wrapped about the heap, [and] seeth the place of stones.

18\_JOB\_08\_18 If he destroy him from his place, then [it] shall deny him, [saying], I have not seen thee.

18\_JOB\_08\_19 Behold, this [is] the joy of his way, and out of the earth shall others grow.

18\_JOB\_08\_20 Behold, God will not cast away a perfect [man], neither will he help the evil doers:

18\_JOB\_08\_21 Till he fill thy mouth with laughing, and thy lips with rejoicing.

18\_JOB\_08\_22 They that hate thee shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nought.
