

## Book of Job Chapter 18

18\_JOB\_18\_01 Then answered Bildad the Shuhite, and said,

18\_JOB\_18\_02 How long [will it be ere] ye make an end of words? mark, and afterwards we will speak.

18\_JOB\_18\_03 Wherefore are we counted as beasts, [and] reputed vile in your sight?

18\_JOB\_18\_04 He teareth himself in his anger: shall the earth be forsaken for thee? and shall the rock be removed out of his place?

18\_JOB\_18\_05 Yea, the light of the wicked shall be put out, and the spark of his fire shall not shine.

18\_JOB\_18\_06 The light shall be dark in his tabernacle, and his candle shall be put out with him.

18\_JOB\_18\_07 The steps of his strength shall be straitened, and his own counsel shall cast him down.

18\_JOB\_18\_08 For he is cast into a net by his own feet, and he walketh upon a snare.

18\_JOB\_18\_09 The gin shall take [him] by the heel, [and] the robber shall prevail against him.

18\_JOB\_18\_10 The snare [is] laid for him in the ground, and a trap for him in the way.

18\_JOB\_18\_11 Terrors shall make him afraid on every side, and shall drive him to his feet.

18\_JOB\_18\_12 His strength shall be hungerbitten, and destruction [shall be] ready at his side.

18\_JOB\_18\_13 It shall devour the strength of his skin: [even] the firstborn of death shall devour his strength.

18\_JOB\_18\_14 His confidence shall be rooted out of his tabernacle, and it shall bring him to the king of terrors.

18\_JOB\_18\_15 It shall dwell in his tabernacle, because [it is] none of his: brimstone shall be scattered upon his habitation.

18\_JOB\_18\_16 His roots shall be dried up beneath, and above shall his branch be cut off.

18\_JOB\_18\_17 His remembrance shall perish from the earth, and he shall have no name in the street.

18\_JOB\_18\_18 He shall be driven from light into darkness, and chased out of the world.

18\_JOB\_18\_19 He shall neither have son nor nephew among his people, nor any remaining in his dwellings.

18\_JOB\_18\_20 They that come after [him] shall be astonished at his day, as they that went before were affrighted.

18\_JOB\_18\_21 Surely such [are] the dwellings of the wicked, and this [is] the place [of him that] knoweth not God.
