Page 1 Book of Job Chapter 22

- 18_JOB_22_01 Then Eliphaz the Temanite answered and said,
- 18_JOB_22_02 Can a man be profitable unto God, as he that is wise may be profitable unto himself?
- $18_JOB_22_03 \ [Is \ it] \ any \ pleasure \ to \ the \ Almighty, \ that \ thou \ art \ righteous? \ or \ [is \ it] \ gain \ [to \ him], \ that \ thou \ makest \ thy \ ways \ perfect?$
- 18_JOB_22_04 Will he reprove thee for fear of thee? will he enter with thee into judgment?
- 18_JOB_22_05 [Is] not thy wickedness great? and thine iniquities infinite?
- 18_JOB_22_06 For thou hast taken a pledge from thy brother for nought, and stripped the naked of their clothing.
- 18_JOB_22_07 Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.
- $18_JOB_22_08$ But [as for] the mighty man, he had the earth; and the honourable man dwelt in it.
- 18_JOB_22_09 Thou hast sent widows away empty, and the arms of the fatherless have been broken.
- 18_JOB_22_10 Therefore snares [are] round about thee, and sudden fear troubleth thee;
- 18 JOB 22 11 Or darkness, [that] thou canst not see; and abundance of waters cover thee.
- 18_JOB_22_12 [Is] not God in the height of heaven? and behold the height of the stars, how high they are!
- $18_JOB_22_13 \ And \ thou \ sayest, How \ doth \ God \ know? \ can \ he \ judge \ through \ the \ dark \ cloud?$
- 18_JOB_22_14 Thick clouds [are] a covering to him, that he seeth not; and he walketh in the circuit of heaven.
- 18_JOB_22_15 Hast thou marked the old way which wicked men have trodden?
- 18 JOB 22 16 Which were cut down out of time, whose foundation was overflown with a flood:
- 18_JOB_22_17 Which said unto God, Depart from us: and what can the Almighty do for them?
- 18_JOB_22_18 Yet he filled their houses with good [things]: but the counsel of the wicked is far from me.
- 18_JOB_22_19 The righteous see [it], and are glad: and the innocent laugh them to scorn.
- 18_JOB_22_20 Whereas our substance is not cut down, but the remnant of them the fire consumeth.
- 18_JOB_22_21 Acquaint now thyself with him, and be at peace: thereby good shall come unto thee.
- 18_JOB_22_22 Receive, I pray thee, the law from his mouth, and lay up his words in thine heart.
- 18_JOB_22_23 If thou return to the Almighty, thou shalt be built up, thou shalt put away iniquity far from thy tabernacles.
- 18_JOB_22_24 Then shalt thou lay up gold as dust, and the [gold] of Ophir as the stones of the brooks.
- 18_JOB_22_25 Yea, the Almighty shall be thy defence, and thou shalt have plenty of silver.
- $18_JOB_22_26 \ For then \ shalt \ thou \ have \ thy \ delight \ in \ the \ Almighty, \ and \ shalt \ lift \ up \ thy \ face \ unto \ God.$
- $18_JOB_22_27$ Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows.
- $18_JOB_22_28\ Thou\ shalt\ also\ decree\ a\ thing,\ and\ it\ shall\ be\ established\ unto\ thee:\ and\ the\ light\ shall\ shine\ upon\ thy\ ways.$
- $18_JOB_22_29 \ When \ [men] \ are \ cast \ down, \ then \ thou \ shalt \ say, \ [There \ is] \ lifting \ up; \ and \ he \ shall \ save \ the \ humble \ person.$
- $18_JOB_22_30 \ He \ shall \ deliver \ the \ island \ of \ the \ innocent: \ and \ it \ is \ delivered \ by \ the \ pureness \ of \ thine \ hands.$
