

## Book of Psalms Chapter 27

19\_PSA\_27\_01 [A Psalm] of David. The LORD [is] my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD [is] the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

19\_PSA\_27\_02 When the wicked, [even] mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

19\_PSA\_27\_03 Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this [will] I [be] confident.

19\_PSA\_27\_04 One [thing] have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to inquire in his temple.

19\_PSA\_27\_05 For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

19\_PSA\_27\_06 And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.

19\_PSA\_27\_07 Hear, O LORD, [when] I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me.

19\_PSA\_27\_08 [When thou saidst], Seek ye my face; my heart said unto thee, Thy face, LORD, will I seek.

19\_PSA\_27\_09 Hide not thy face [far] from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

19\_PSA\_27\_10 When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.

19\_PSA\_27\_11 Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.

19\_PSA\_27\_12 Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

19\_PSA\_27\_13 [I had fainted], unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living.

19\_PSA\_27\_14 Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.
