

## Book of Psalms Chapter 30

19\_PSA\_30\_01 A Psalm [and] Song [at] the dedication of the house of David. I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

19\_PSA\_30\_02 O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.

19\_PSA\_30\_03 O LORD, thou hast brought up my soul from the grave: thou hast kept me alive, that I should not go down to the pit.

19\_PSA\_30\_04 Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness.

19\_PSA\_30\_05 For his anger [endureth but] a moment; in his favour [is] life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy [cometh] in the morning.

19\_PSA\_30\_06 And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved.

19\_PSA\_30\_07 LORD, by thy favour thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, [and] I was troubled.

19\_PSA\_30\_08 I cried to thee, O LORD; and unto the LORD I made supplication.

19\_PSA\_30\_09 What profit [is there] in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy truth?

19\_PSA\_30\_10 Hear, O LORD, and have mercy upon me: LORD, be thou my helper.

19\_PSA\_30\_11 Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness;

19\_PSA\_30\_12 To the end that [my] glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever.
