Page 1 **Book of Psalms Chapter 73**

- 19_PSA_73_01 A Psalm of Asaph. Truly God [is] good to Israel, [even] to such as are of a clean heart.
- 19_PSA_73_02 But as for me, my feet were almost gone; my steps had well nigh slipped.
- 19_PSA_73_03 For I was envious at the foolish, [when] I saw the prosperity of the wicked.
- 19_PSA_73_04 For [there are] no bands in their death: but their strength [is] firm.
- 19_PSA_73_05 They [are] not in trouble [as other] men; neither are they plagued like [other] men.
- 19_PSA_73_06 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them [as] a garment.
- 19_PSA_73_07 Their eyes stand out with fatness: they have more than heart could wish.
- 19_PSA_73_08 They are corrupt, and speak wickedly [concerning] oppression: they speak loftily.
- 19_PSA_73_09 They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walketh through the earth.
- 19_PSA_73_10 Therefore his people return hither: and waters of a full [cup] are wrung out to them.
- 19 PSA 73 11 And they say, How doth God know? and is there knowledge in the most High?
- 19_PSA_73_12 Behold, these [are] the ungodly, who prosper in the world; they increase [in] riches.
- 19_PSA_73_13 Verily I have cleansed my heart [in] vain, and washed my hands in innocency.
- $19_PSA_73_14$ For all the day long have I been plagued, and chastened every morning.
- 19_PSA_73_15 If I say, I will speak thus; behold, I should offend [against] the generation of thy children.
- 19 PSA 73 16 When I thought to know this, it [was] too painful for me;
- 19_PSA_73_17 Until I went into the sanctuary of God; [then] understood I their end.
- $19_PSA_73_18 \ Surely \ thou \ didst \ set \ them \ in \ slippery \ places: \ thou \ casted st \ them \ down \ into \ destruction.$
- 19_PSA_73_19 How are they [brought] into desolation, as in a moment! they are utterly consumed with terrors.
- 19_PSA_73_20 As a dream when [one] awaketh; [so], O Lord, when thou awakest, thou shalt despise their image.
- 19_PSA_73_21 Thus my heart was grieved, and I was pricked in my reins.
- 19_PSA_73_22 So foolish [was] I, and ignorant: I was [as] a beast before thee.
- $19_PSA_73_23 \ Nevertheless \ I \ [am] \ continually \ with \ thee: \ thou \ hast \ holden \ [me] \ by \ my \ right \ hand.$
- 19_PSA_73_24 Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me [to] glory.
- 19_PSA_73_25 Whom have I in heaven [but thee]? and [there is] none upon earth [that] I desire beside thee.
- 19_PSA_73_26 My flesh and my heart faileth: [but] God [is] the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever.
- 19_PSA_73_27 For, lo, they that are far from thee shall perish: thou hast destroyed all them that go a whoring from thee.
- $19_PSA_73_28~But~[it~is]~good~for~me~to~draw~near~to~God:I~have~put~my~trust~in~the~Lord~GOD,~that~I~may~declare~all~thy~works.$
