- 19_PSA_108_02 Awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.
- 19_PSA_108_03 I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.
- 19_PSA_108_04 For thy mercy [is] great above the heavens: and thy truth [reacheth] unto the clouds.
