## **Book of Isaiah Chapter 32**

- 23\_ISA\_32\_01 Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in judgment.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_02 And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_03 And the eyes of them that see shall not be dim, and the ears of them that hear shall hearken.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_04 The heart also of the rash shall understand knowledge, and the tongue of the stammerers shall be ready to speak plainly.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_05 The vile person shall be no more called liberal, nor the churl said [to be] bountiful.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_06 For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work iniquity, to practice hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_07 The instruments also of the churl [are] evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_08 But the liberal deviseth liberal things; and by liberal things shall he stand.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_09 Rise up, ye women that are at ease; hear my voice, ye careless daughters; give ear unto my speech.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_10 Many days and years shall ye be troubled, ye careless women: for the vintage shall fail, the gathering shall not come.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_11 Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird [sackcloth] upon [your] loins.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_12 They shall lament for the teats, for the pleasant fields, for the fruitful vine.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_13 Upon the land of my people shall come up thorns [and] briers; yea, upon all the houses of joy [in] the joyous city:
- 23\_ISA\_32\_14 Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens for ever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks;
- 23\_ISA\_32\_15 Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_16 Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_17 And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_18 And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places;
- 23\_ISA\_32\_19 When it shall hail, coming down on the forest; and the city shall be low in a low place.
- 23\_ISA\_32\_20 Blessed [are] ye that sow beside all waters, that send forth [thither] the feet of the ox and the ass.
