## **Book of Lamentations Chapter 03**

- 25\_LAM\_03\_01 I [am] the man [that] hath seen affliction by the rod of his wrath.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_02 He hath led me, and brought [me into] darkness, but not [into] light.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_03 Surely against me is he turned; he turneth his hand [against me] all the day.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_04 My flesh and my skin hath he made old: he hath broken my bones.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_05 He hath builded against me, and compassed [me] with gall and travail.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_06 He hath set me in dark places, as [they that be] dead of old.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_07 He hath hedged me about, that I cannot get out: he hath made my chain heavy.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_08 Also when I cry and shout, he shutteth out my prayer.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_09 He hath enclosed my ways with hewn stone, he hath made my paths crooked.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_10 He [was] unto me [as] a bear lying in wait, [and as] a lion in secret places.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_11 He hath turned aside my ways, and pulled me in pieces: he hath made me desolate.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_12 He hath bent his bow, and set me as a mark for the arrow.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_13 He hath caused the arrows of his quiver to enter into my reins.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_14 I was a derision to all my people; [and] their song all the day.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_15 He hath filled me with bitterness, he hath made me drunken with wormwood.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_16 He hath also broken my teeth with gravel stones, he hath covered me with ashes.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_17 And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgat prosperity.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_18 And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD:
- 25\_LAM\_03\_19 Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_20 My soul hath [them] still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_21 This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_22 [It is of] the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_23 [They are] new every morning: great [is] thy faithfulness.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_24 The LORD [is] my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_25 The LORD [is] good unto them that wait for him, to the soul [that] seeketh him.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_26 [It is] good that [a man] should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_27 [It is] good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.

- 25\_LAM\_03\_28 He sitteth alone and keepeth silence, because he hath borne [it] upon him.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_29 He putteth his mouth in the dust; if so be there may be hope.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_30 He giveth [his] cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full with reproach.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_31 For the Lord will not cast off for ever:
- 25\_LAM\_03\_32 But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_33 For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_34 To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth,
- 25\_LAM\_03\_35 To turn aside the right of a man before the face of the most High,
- 25\_LAM\_03\_36 To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approveth not.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_37 Who [is] he [that] saith, and it cometh to pass, [when] the Lord commandeth [it] not?
- 25\_LAM\_03\_38 Out of the mouth of the most High proceedeth not evil and good?
- 25\_LAM\_03\_39 Wherefore doth a living man complain, a man for the punishment of his sins?
- 25\_LAM\_03\_40 Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_41 Let us lift up our heart with [our] hands unto God in the heavens.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_42 We have transgressed and have rebelled: thou hast not pardoned.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_43 Thou hast covered with anger, and persecuted us: thou hast slain, thou hast not pitied.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_44 Thou hast covered thyself with a cloud, that [our] prayer should not pass through.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_45 Thou hast made us [as] the offscouring and refuse in the midst of the people.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_46 All our enemies have opened their mouths against us.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_47 Fear and a snare is come upon us, desolation and destruction.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_48 Mine eye runneth down with rivers of water for the destruction of the daughter of my people.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_49 Mine eye trickleth down, and ceaseth not, without any intermission,
- 25\_LAM\_03\_50 Till the LORD look down, and behold from heaven.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_51 Mine eye affecteth mine heart because of all the daughters of my city.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_52 Mine enemies chased me sore, like a bird, without cause.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_53 They have cut off my life in the dungeon, and cast a stone upon me.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_54 Waters flowed over mine head; [then] I said, I am cut off.

- 25\_LAM\_03\_55 I called upon thy name, O LORD, out of the low dungeon.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_56 Thou hast heard my voice: hide not thine ear at my breathing, at my cry.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_57 Thou drewest near in the day [that] I called upon thee: thou saidst, Fear not.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_58 O Lord, thou hast pleaded the causes of my soul; thou hast redeemed my life.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_59 O LORD, thou hast seen my wrong: judge thou my cause.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_60 Thou hast seen all their vengeance [and] all their imaginations against me.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_61 Thou hast heard their reproach, O LORD, [and] all their imaginations against me;
- 25\_LAM\_03\_62 The lips of those that rose up against me, and their device against me all the day.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_63 Behold their sitting down, and their rising up; I [am] their music.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_64 Render unto them a recompense, O LORD, according to the work of their hands.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_65 Give them sorrow of heart, thy curse unto them.
- 25\_LAM\_03\_66 Persecute and destroy them in anger from under the heavens of the LORD.
