**Book of Matthew Chapter 14**

40\_MAT\_14\_01 At that time Herod the tetrarch heard of the fame of Jesus,

40\_MAT\_14\_02 And said unto his servants, This is John the Baptist; he is risen from the dead; and therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him.

40\_MAT\_14\_03 For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

40\_MAT\_14\_04 For John said unto him, It is not lawful for thee to have her.

40\_MAT\_14\_05 And when he would have put him to death, he feared the multitude, because they counted him as a prophet.

40\_MAT\_14\_06 But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.

40\_MAT\_14\_07 Whereupon he promised with an oath to give her whatsoever she would ask.

40\_MAT\_14\_08 And she, being before instructed of her mother, said, Give me here John Baptist's head in a charger.

40\_MAT\_14\_09 And the king was sorry: nevertheless for the oath's sake, and them which sat with him at meat, he commanded [it] to be given [her].

40\_MAT\_14\_10 And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.

40\_MAT\_14\_11 And his head was brought in a charger, and given to the damsel: and she brought [it] to her mother.

40\_MAT\_14\_12 And his disciples came, and took up the body, and buried it, and went and told Jesus.

40\_MAT\_14\_13 When Jesus heard [of it], he departed thence by ship into a desert place apart: and when the people had heard [thereof], they followed him on foot out of the cities.

40\_MAT\_14\_14 And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.

40\_MAT\_14\_15 And when it was evening, his disciples came to him, saying, This is a desert place, and the time is now past; send the multitude away, that they may go into the villages, and buy themselves victuals.

40\_MAT\_14\_16 But Jesus said unto them, They need not depart; give ye them to eat.

40\_MAT\_14\_17 And they say unto him, We have here but five loaves, and two fishes.

40\_MAT\_14\_18 He said, Bring them hither to me.

40\_MAT\_14\_19 And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed, and brake, and gave the loaves to [his] disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

40\_MAT\_14\_20 And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the fragments that remained twelve baskets full.

40\_MAT\_14\_21 And they that had eaten were about five thousand men, beside women and children.

40\_MAT\_14\_22 And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away.

40\_MAT\_14\_23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

40\_MAT\_14\_24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary.

40\_MAT\_14\_25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.

40\_MAT\_14\_26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.

40\_MAT\_14\_27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

40\_MAT\_14\_28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.

40\_MAT\_14\_29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

40\_MAT\_14\_30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

40\_MAT\_14\_31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth [his] hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

40\_MAT\_14\_32 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.

40\_MAT\_14\_33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

40\_MAT\_14\_34 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret.

40\_MAT\_14\_35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased;

40\_MAT\_14\_36 And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.
