

## Book of Mark Chapter 12

41\_MAR\_12\_01 And he began to speak unto them by parables. A [certain] man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about [it], and digged [a place for] the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country.

41\_MAR\_12\_02 And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard.

41\_MAR\_12\_03 And they caught [him], and beat him, and sent [him] away empty.

41\_MAR\_12\_04 And again he sent unto them another servant; and at him they cast stones, and wounded [him] in the head, and sent [him] away shamefully handled.

41\_MAR\_12\_05 And again he sent another; and him they killed, and many others; beating some, and killing some.

41\_MAR\_12\_06 Having yet therefore one son, his wellbeloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will reverence my son.

41\_MAR\_12\_07 But those husbandmen said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours.

41\_MAR\_12\_08 And they took him, and killed [him], and cast [him] out of the vineyard.

41\_MAR\_12\_09 What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? he will come and destroy the husbandmen, and will give the vineyard unto others.

41\_MAR\_12\_10 And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner:

41\_MAR\_12\_11 This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

41\_MAR\_12\_12 And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way.

41\_MAR\_12\_13 And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in [his] words.

41\_MAR\_12\_14 And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?

41\_MAR\_12\_15 Shall we give, or shall we not give? But he, knowing their hypocrisy, said unto them, Why tempt ye me? bring me a penny, that I may see [it].

41\_MAR\_12\_16 And they brought [it]. And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.

41\_MAR\_12\_17 And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

41\_MAR\_12\_18 Then come unto him the Sadducees, which say there is no resurrection; and they asked him, saying,

41\_MAR\_12\_19 Master, Moses wrote unto us, If a man's brother die, and leave [his] wife [behind him], and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

41\_MAR\_12\_20 Now there were seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and dying left no seed.

41\_MAR\_12\_21 And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise.

41\_MAR\_12\_22 And the seven had her, and left no seed: last of all the woman died also.

41\_MAR\_12\_23 In the resurrection therefore, when they shall rise, whose wife shall she be of them? for the seven had her to wife.

41\_MAR\_12\_24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

41\_MAR\_12\_25 For when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven.

41\_MAR\_12\_26 And as touching the dead, that they rise: have ye not read in the book of Moses, how in the bush God spake unto him, saying, I [am] the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob?

41\_MAR\_12\_27 He is not the God of the dead, but the God of the living: ye therefore do greatly err.

41\_MAR\_12\_28 And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

41\_MAR\_12\_29 And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments [is], Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

41\_MAR\_12\_30 And thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all thy strength: this [is] the first commandment.

41\_MAR\_12\_31 And the second [is] like, [namely] this, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. There is none other commandment greater than these.

41\_MAR\_12\_32 And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he:

41\_MAR\_12\_33 And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love [his] neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

41\_MAR\_12\_34 And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou art not far from the kingdom of God. And no man after that durst ask him [any question].

41\_MAR\_12\_35 And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David?

41\_MAR\_12\_36 For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

41\_MAR\_12\_37 David therefore himself calleth him Lord; and whence is he [then] his son? And the common people heard him gladly.

41\_MAR\_12\_38 And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and [love] salutations in the marketplaces,

41\_MAR\_12\_39 And the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at feasts:

41\_MAR\_12\_40 Which devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayers: these shall receive greater damnation.

41\_MAR\_12\_41 And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.

41\_MAR\_12\_42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.

41\_MAR\_12\_43 And he called [unto him] his disciples, and saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That this poor widow hath cast more in, than all they which have cast into the treasury:

41\_MAR\_12\_44 For all [they] did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, [even] all her living.
