Page 1 Book of 1st Corinthians Chapter 03

46_1CO_03_01 And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, [even] as unto babes in Christ.

46_1CO_03_02 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.

46_1CO_03_03 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas [there is] among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

46_1CO_03_04 For while one saith, I am of Paul; and another, I [am] of Apollos; are ye not carnal?

46_1CO_03_05 Who then is Paul, and who [is] Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?

46_1CO_03_06 I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the increase.

46_1CO_03_07 So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neither he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase.

46_1CO_03_08 Now he that planteth and he that watereth are one: and every man shall receive his own reward according to his own labour.

46_1CO_03_09 For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, [ye are] God's building.

46_1CO_03_10 According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

46_1CO_03_11 For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

46_1CO_03_12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;

46_1CO_03_13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

46_1CO_03_14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

46_1CO_03_15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

46_1CO_03_16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and [that] the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?

46_1CO_03_17 If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which [temple] ye are.

46_1CO_03_18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

46_1CO_03_19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

46 1CO 03 20 And again, The Lord knoweth the thoughts of the wise, that they are vain.

46_1CO_03_21 Therefore let no man glory in men. For all things are yours;

46_1CO_03_22 Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours;

46_1CO_03_23 And ye are Christ's; and Christ [is] God's.
