Book of 1st Corinthians Chapter 06

- 46_1CO_06_01 Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust, and not before the saints?
- 46_1CO_06_02 Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?
- $46_1CO_06_03 \; Know \; ye \; not \; that \; we \; shall \; judge \; angels? \; how \; much \; more \; things \; that \; pertain \; to \; this \; life?$
- $46_1CO_06_04$ If then ye have judgments of things pertaining to this life, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church.
- $46_1CO_06_05 \ I \ speak \ to \ your \ shame. \ Is \ it \ so, \ that \ there \ is \ not \ a \ wise \ man \ among \ you? \ no, \ not \ one \ that \ shall \ be \ able \ to \ judge \ between \ his \ brethren?$
- 46_1CO_06_06 But brother goeth to law with brother, and that before the unbelievers.
- 46_1CO_06_07 Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather [suffer yourselves to] be defrauded?
- 46_1CO_06_08 Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that [your] brethren.
- 46_1CO_06_09 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind,
- 46_1CO_06_10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God.
- 46_1CO_06_11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
- 46_1CO_06_12 All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.
- 46_1CO_06_13 Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body [is] not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body.
- $46_1CO_06_14 \ And \ God \ hath \ both \ raised \ up \ the \ Lord, \ and \ will \ also \ raise \ up \ us \ by \ his \ own \ power.$
- 46_1CO_06_15 Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make [them] the members of an harlot? God forbid.
- 46 1CO 06 16 What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh.
- 46_1CO_06_17 But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.
- $46_1CO_06_18$ Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body.
- 46_1CO_06_19 What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost [which is] in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own?
- 46_1CO_06_20 For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.
