**Book of Ephesians Chapter 0**

49\_EPH\_04\_01 I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

49\_EPH\_04\_02 With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love;

49\_EPH\_04\_03 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

49\_EPH\_04\_04 [There is] one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling;

49\_EPH\_04\_05 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

49\_EPH\_04\_06 One God and Father of all, who [is] above all, and through all, and in you all.

49\_EPH\_04\_07 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

49\_EPH\_04\_08 Wherefore he saith, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men.

49\_EPH\_04\_09 [Now that he ascended, what is it but that he also descended first into the lower parts of the earth?

49\_EPH\_04\_10 He that descended is the same also that ascended up far above all heavens, that he might fill all things.]

49\_EPH\_04\_11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

49\_EPH\_04\_12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

49\_EPH\_04\_13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

49\_EPH\_04\_14 That we [henceforth] be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, [and] cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;

49\_EPH\_04\_15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, [even] Christ:

49\_EPH\_04\_16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

49\_EPH\_04\_17 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind,

49\_EPH\_04\_18 Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

49\_EPH\_04\_19 Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness.

49\_EPH\_04\_20 But ye have not so learned Christ;

49\_EPH\_04\_21 If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus:

49\_EPH\_04\_22 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

49\_EPH\_04\_23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

49\_EPH\_04\_24 And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

49\_EPH\_04\_25 Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.

49\_EPH\_04\_26 Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath:

49\_EPH\_04\_27 Neither give place to the devil.

49\_EPH\_04\_28 Let him that stole steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with [his] hands the thing which is good, that he may have to give to him that needeth.

49\_EPH\_04\_29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

49\_EPH\_04\_30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

49\_EPH\_04\_31 Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

49\_EPH\_04\_32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.
