

## Book of 2nd Thessalonians Chapter 03

53\_2TH\_03\_01 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have [free] course, and be glorified, even as [it is] with you:

53\_2TH\_03\_02 And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all [men] have not faith.

53\_2TH\_03\_03 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep [you] from evil.

53\_2TH\_03\_04 And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you.

53\_2TH\_03\_05 And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ.

53\_2TH\_03\_06 Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us.

53\_2TH\_03\_07 For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;

53\_2TH\_03\_08 Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you:

53\_2TH\_03\_09 Not because we have not power, but to make ourselves an ensample unto you to follow us.

53\_2TH\_03\_10 For even when we were with you, this we commanded you, that if any would not work, neither should he eat.

53\_2TH\_03\_11 For we hear that there are some which walk among you disorderly, working not at all, but are busybodies.

53\_2TH\_03\_12 Now them that are such we command and exhort by our Lord Jesus Christ, that with quietness they work, and eat their own bread.

53\_2TH\_03\_13 But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

53\_2TH\_03\_14 And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed.

53\_2TH\_03\_15 Yet count [him] not as an enemy, but admonish [him] as a brother.

53\_2TH\_03\_16 Now the Lord of peace himself give you peace always by all means. The Lord [be] with you all.

53\_2TH\_03\_17 The salutation of Paul with mine own hand, which is the token in every epistle: so I write.

53\_2TH\_03\_18 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ [be] with you all. Amen.
