Page 1 **Book of 1st Timothy Chapter 06**

- 54_1TI_06_01 Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and [his] doctrine be not blasphemed.
- 54_1TI_06_02 And they that have believing masters, let them not despise [them], because they are brethren; but rather do [them] service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort.
- 54_1TI_06_03 If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, [even] the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness;
- $54_1TI_06_04$ He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings,
- 54_1TI_06_05 Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.
- 54_1TI_06_06 But godliness with contentment is great gain.
- 54_1TI_06_07 For we brought nothing into [this] world, [and it is] certain we can carry nothing out.
- 54_1TI_06_08 And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.
- 54_1TI_06_09 But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and [into] many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.
- 54_1TI_06_10 For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
- 54_1TI_06_11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.
- 54_1TI_06_12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.
- 54_1TI_06_13 I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and [before] Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;
- $54_1TI_06_14\ That\ thou\ keep\ [this]\ commandment\ without\ spot,\ unrebukeable,\ until \ the\ appearing\ of\ our\ Lord\ Jesus\ Christ:$
- $54_1TI_06_15 \ Which in his times he shall show, [who is] \ the \ blessed \ and \ only \ Potentate, the \ King \ of kings, and \ Lord \ of \ lords;$
- 54_1TI_06_16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom [be] honour and power everlasting. Amen.
- 54_1TI_06_17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;
- $54_1TI_06_18$ That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;
- 54_1TI_06_19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.
- 54_1TI_06_20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane [and] vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:
- 54_1TI_06_21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace [be] with thee. Amen.
