

## Book of 2nd Timothy Chapter 03

55\_2TI\_03\_01 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

55\_2TI\_03\_02 For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy,

55\_2TI\_03\_03 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good,

55\_2TI\_03\_04 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

55\_2TI\_03\_05 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away.

55\_2TI\_03\_06 For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

55\_2TI\_03\_07 Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

55\_2TI\_03\_08 Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.

55\_2TI\_03\_09 But they shall proceed no further: for their folly shall be manifest unto all [men], as theirs also was.

55\_2TI\_03\_10 But thou hast fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, patience,

55\_2TI\_03\_11 Persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of [them] all the Lord delivered me.

55\_2TI\_03\_12 Yea, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution.

55\_2TI\_03\_13 But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived.

55\_2TI\_03\_14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned [them];

55\_2TI\_03\_15 And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.

55\_2TI\_03\_16 All scripture [is] given by inspiration of God, and [is] profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

55\_2TI\_03\_17 That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.
