- 01\_GEN\_08\_01 [And God remembered Noah, And every living thing, And all the cattle that \[ was \] with him in the ark ; And God made A wind to pass over the earth, And the waters asswaged ;](#)
- 01\_GEN\_08\_02 [the fountains also of the deep And the windows of heaven were stopped, And the rain from heaven was restrained ;](#)
- 01\_GEN\_08\_03 [And the waters returned from off the earth continually ; And after the end of the hundred And fifty days the waters were abated .](#)
- 01\_GEN\_08\_04 [And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat .](#)
- 01\_GEN\_08\_05 [And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month ; in the tenth \[ month \], on the first \[ day \] of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen .](#)

- 01\_GEN\_08\_09 [but the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, And she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters \[ were \] on the face of the whole earth ; Then he put forth his hand, And took her, And pulled her in unto him into the ark .](#)

- 01\_GEN\_08\_13 [And it came to pass in the six hundredth And first year, in the first \[ month \], the first \[ day \] of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth ; And Noah removed the covering of the ark, And looked, And, behold, the face of the ground was dry .](#)
