- 01\_GEN\_21\_01 [And the LORD visited Sarah as he had said, And the LORD did unto Sarah as he had spoken.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_02 [for Sarah conceived, And bare Abraham A son in his old age, at the set time of which God had spoken to him.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_03 [And Abraham called the name of his son that was born unto him, whom Sarah bare to him, Isaac.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_04 [And Abraham circumcised his son Isaac being eight days old, as God had commanded him.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_05 [And Abraham was an hundred years old, when his son Isaac was born unto him.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_06 [And Sarah said, God hath made me to laugh, \[ So that \] all that hear will laugh with me.](#)

- 01\_GEN\_21\_12 [And God said unto Abraham, let it not be grievous in thy sight because of the lad, And because of thy bondwoman; in all that Sarah hath said unto thee, hearken unto her voice; for in Isaac shall thy seed be called.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_13 [And also of the son of the bondwoman will I make A nation, because he \[ Is \] thy seed.](#)
- 01\_GEN\_21\_14 [And Abraham rose up early in the morning, And took bread, And A bottle of water, And gave \[ it \] unto Hagar, putting \[ it \] on her shoulder, And the child, And sent her away: And she departed, And wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba.](#)
