01_GEN_43_02 [And it came to pass , when they had eaten up the corn which they had brought out of Egypt , their Father said unto them , go again , buy us A little food .](#)

01_GEN_43_03 [And Judah spake unto him , saying , the man did solemnly protest unto us , saying , ye shall not see my face , except your brother \[be \] with you .](#)

01_GEN_43_04 [if thou wilt send our brother with us , we will go down And buy thee food :](#)

01_GEN_43_05 [but if thou wilt not send \[him \] , we will not go down : for the man said unto us , ye shall not see my face , except your brother \[be \] with you .](#)

01_GEN_43_06 [And Israel said , Wherefore dealt ye \[So \] ill with me , \[as \] to tell the man whether ye had yet A brother ?](#)

01_GEN_43_07 [And they said , the man asked us straitly of our state , And of our kindred , saying , \[Is \] your Father yet alive ? have ye \[another \] brother ? And we told him according to the tenor of These words : could we certainly know that he would say , bring your brother down ?](#)

01_GEN_43_08 [And Judah said unto Israel his Father , send the lad with me , And we will Arise And go ; that we may live , And not die , Both we , And thou , \[And \] also our little ones .](#)

01_GEN_43_09 [I will be surety for him ; of my hand shalt thou require him : if I bring him not unto thee , And set him before thee , Then let me bear the blame for ever :](#)

01_GEN_43_11 [And their Father Israel said unto them , if \[it must be \] So now , do this ; take of the best fruits in the land in your vessels , And carry down the man A present , A little balm , And A little honey , spices , And myrrh , nuts , And almonds :](#)

01_GEN_43_12 [And take double money in your hand ; And the money that was brought again in the mouth of your sacks , carry \[it \] again in your hand ; Peradventure it \[was \] an oversight :](#)

01_GEN_43_21 [And it came to pass , when we came to the inn , that we opened our sacks , And , behold , \[every \] man's money \[was \] in the mouth of his sack , our money in full weight ; And we have brought it again in our hand .](#)

01_GEN_43_22 [And other money have we brought down in our hands to buy food : we cannot tell who put our money in our sacks .](#)

01_GEN_43_23 [And he said , peace \[be \] to you , Fear not : your God , And the God of your Father , hath given you treasure in your sacks : I had your money . And he brought Simeon out unto them .](#)

01_GEN_43_24 [And the man brought the men into Joseph's house , And gave \[them \] water , And they washed their feet ; And he gave their asses provender .](#)

01_GEN_43_25 [And they made ready the present against Joseph came at noon ; for they heard that they should eat bread there .](#)

01_GEN_43_26 [And when Joseph came home , they brought him the present which \[was \] in their hand into the house , And bowed themselves to him to the earth .](#)
