- 09\_ISA\_23\_01 [Then they told David, saying, behold, the Philistines fight against Keilah, And they rob the threshingfloors.](#)
- 09\_ISA\_23\_02 [therefore David inquired of the LORD, saying, shall I go And smite These Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, go, And smite the Philistines, And save Keilah.](#)
- 09\_ISA\_23\_03 [And David's men said unto him, behold, we be afraid here in Judah: how much more Then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?](#)
- 09\_ISA\_23\_04 [Then David inquired of the LORD yet again, And the LORD answered him And said, Arise, go down to Keilah: for I will deliver the Philistines into thine hand.](#)
- 09\_ISA\_23\_05 [So David And his men went to Keilah, And fought with the Philistines, And brought away their cattle, And smote them with A great slaughter. So David saved the inhabitants of Keilah.](#)
