- 14\_2CH\_25\_01 [Amaziah \[ was \] twenty And five years old \[ when \] he began to reign , And he reigned twenty And nine years in Jerusalem , And his mother's name \[ was \] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_02 [And he did \[ that which was \] right in the sight of the LORD , but not with A perfect heart .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_03 [now it came to pass , when the kingdom was established to him , that he slew his servants that had killed the king his Father .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_04 [but he slew not their children , but \[ did \] as \[ it Is \] written in the law in the book of Moses , where the LORD commanded , saving , the fathers shall not die for the children , neither shall the children die for the fathers , but every man shall die for his own sin .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_05 [moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together , And made them captains over thousands , And captains over hundreds , according to the houses of \[ their \] fathers , throughout all Judah And Benjamin ; And he numbered them from twenty years old And above , And found them three hundred thousand choice \[ men , able \] to go forth to war , that could handle spear And shield .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_06 [he hired also an hundred thousand mighty men of valour out of Israel for an hundred talents of silver .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_07 [but there came A man of God to him , saving , O king , let not the army of Israel go with thee ; for the LORD \[ Is \] not with Israel , \[ to wit , with \] all the children of Ephraim .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_08 [but if thou wilt go , do \[ it \] , be strong for the battle : God shall make thee fall before the enemy : for God hath power to help , And to cast down .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_09 [And Amaziah said to the man of God , but what shall we do for the hundred talents which I have given to the army of Israel ? And the man of God answered , the LORD Is able to give thee much more than this .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_10 [Then Amaziah separated them , \[ to wit \] , the army that was come to him out of Ephraim , to go home again : Wherefore their anger was greatly kindled against Judah , And they returned home in great anger .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_11 [And Amaziah strengthened himself , And led forth his people , And went to the valley of salt , And smote of the children of Seir ten thousand .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_12 [And \[ other \] ten thousand \[ left \] alive did the children of Judah carry away captive , And brought them unto the top of the rock , And cast them down from the top of the rock , that they all were broken in pieces .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_13 [but the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back , that they should not go with him to battle , fell upon the cities of Judah , from Samaria even unto Bethhoron , And smote three thousand of them , And took much spoil .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_14 [now it came to pass , after that Amaziah was come from the slaughter of the Edomites , that he brought the gods of the children of Seir , And set them up \[ to be \] his gods , And bowed down himself before them , And burned incense unto them .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_15 [Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah , And he sent unto him A prophet , which said unto him , why hast thou sought after the gods of the people , which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand ?](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_16 [And it came to pass , as he talked with him , that \[ the king \] said unto him , art thou made of the king's counsel ? forbear ; why shouldst thou be smitten ? Then the prophet forbare , And said , I know that God hath determined to destroy thee , because thou hast done this , And hast not hearkened unto my counsel .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_17 [Then Amaziah king of Judah took advice , And sent to Joash , the son of Jehoahaz , the son of Jehu , king of Israel , saving , come , let us see one another in the face .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_18 [And Joash king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah , saving , the thistle that \[ was \] in Lebanon sent to the cedar that \[ was \] in Lebanon , saving , give thy daughter to my son to wife : And there passed by A wild beast that \[ was \] in Lebanon , And trode down the thistle .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_19 [thou savest , Lo , thou hast smitten the Edomites ; And thine heart lifteth thee up to boast : abide now at home ; why shouldst thou meddle to \[ thine \] hurt , that thou shouldst fall , \[ even \] thou , And Judah with thee ?](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_20 [but Amaziah would not hear ; for it \[ came \] of God , that he might deliver them into the hand \[ of their enemies \] , because they sought after the gods of Edom .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_21 [So Joash the king of Israel went up ; And they saw one another in the face , \[ Both \] he And Amaziah king of Judah , at Bethshemesh , which \[ belongeth \] to Judah .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_22 [And Judah was put to the worse before Israel , And they fled every man to his tent .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_23 [And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah , the son of Joash , the son of Jehoahaz , at Bethshemesh , And brought him to Jerusalem , And brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate , four hundred cubits .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_24 [And \[ he took \] all the gold And the silver , And all the vessels that were found in the house of God with Obedom , And the treasures of the king's house , the hostages also , And returned to Samaria .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_25 [And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_26 [now the rest of the acts of Amaziah , first And last , behold , \[ are \] they not written in the book of the kings of Judah And Israel ?](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_27 [now after the time that Amaziah did turn away from following the LORD they made A conspiracy against him in Jerusalem ; And he fled to Lachish ; but they sent to Lachish after him , And slew him there .](#)
- 14\_2CH\_25\_28 [And they brought him upon horses , And buried him with his fathers in the city of Judah .](#)
