23_ISA_05_02 [And he fenced it, And gathered out the stones thereof, And planted it with the choicest vine, And built A tower in the midst of it, And also made A winepress therein : And he looked that it should bring forth grapes, And it brought forth wild grapes.](#)

23_ISA_05_03 [And now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem, And men of Judah, judge, I pray you, betwixt me And my vineyard.](#)

23_ISA_05_04 [what could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it ? Wherefore, when I looked that it should bring forth grapes, brought it forth wild grapes ?](#)

23_ISA_05_05 [And now go to ; I will tell you what I will do to my vineyard : I will take away the hedge thereof, And it shall be eaten up ; \[And \] break down the wall thereof, And it shall be trodden down :](#)

23_ISA_05_06 [And I will lav it waste : it shall not be pruned, nor digged ; but there shall come up briars And thorns ; I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it.](#)

23_ISA_05_07 [for the vineyard of the LORD of hosts \[Is \] the house of Israel, And the men of Judah his pleasant plant : And he looked for judgment, but behold oppression ; for righteousness, but behold A cry.](#)

23_ISA_05_11 [woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, \[that \] they may follow strong drink ; that continue until night, \[till \] wine inflame them !](#)

23_ISA_05_12 [And the harp, And the viol, the tabret, And pipe, And wine, are in their feasts ; but they regard not the work of the LORD, neither consider the operation of his hands.](#)

23_ISA_05_13 [therefore my people are gone into captivity, because \[they have \] no knowledge ; And their honourable men \[are \] famished, And their multitude dried up with thirst.](#)

23_ISA_05_14 [therefore hell hath enlarged herself, And opened her mouth without measure ; And their glory, And their multitude, And their pomp, And he that rejoiceth, shall descend into it.](#)

23_ISA_05_22 [woe unto \[them that are \] mighty to drink wine, And men of strength to mingle strong drink :](#)
