- 23\_ISA\_10\_01 [woe unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, And that write grievousness \[ which \] they have prescribed;](#)
- 23\_ISA\_10\_02 [to turn aside the needy from judgment, And to take away the right from the poor of my people, that widows may be their prey, And \[ that \] they may rob the fatherless;](#)
- 23\_ISA\_10\_03 [And what will ye do in the day of visitation, And in the desolation \[ which \] shall come from far? to whom will ye flee for help? And where will ye leave your glory?](#)
- 23\_ISA\_10\_04 [without me they shall bow down under the prisoners, And they shall fall under the slain, for all this his anger Is not turned away, but his hand \[ Is \] stretched out still.](#)
