23\_ISA\_52\_01 **Awake, Awake; put on thy strength, O Zion; put on thy beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city: for henceforth there shall no more come into thee the uncircumcised And the unclean.**

23\_ISA\_52\_02 **shake thyself from the dust; Arise, [ And ] sit down, O Jerusalem: Loose thyself from the bands of thy neck, O captive daughter of Zion.**

23\_ISA\_52\_03 **for thus saith the LORD, ye have sold yourselves for nought; And ye shall be redeemed without money.**

23\_ISA\_52\_04 **for thus saith the LORD God, my people went down aforetime into Egypt to sojourn there; And the Assyrian oppressed them without cause.**

23\_ISA\_52\_05 **now therefore, what have I here, saith the LORD, that my people Is taken away for nought? they that rule over them make them to howl, saith the LORD; And my name continually every day [ Is ] blasphemed.**

23\_ISA\_52\_06 **therefore my people shall know my name: therefore [ they shall know ] in that day that I [ am ] he that Doth speak: behold, [ it Is ] I.**

23\_ISA\_52\_07 **how beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace; that bringeth good tidings of good, that publisheth salvation; that saith unto Zion, thy God reigneth!**

23\_ISA\_52\_08 **thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.**

23\_ISA\_52\_09 **break forth into joy, sing together, ye waste places of Jerusalem: for the LORD hath comforted his people, he hath redeemed Jerusalem.**

23\_ISA\_52\_10 **the LORD hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations; And all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God.**

23\_ISA\_52\_11 **Depart ye, Depart ye, go ye out from thence, touch no unclean [ thing ]; go ye out of the midst of her; be ye clean, that bear the vessels of the LORD.**

23\_ISA\_52\_12 **for ye shall not go out with haste, nor go by flight: for the LORD will go before you; And the God of Israel [ will be ] your rereward.**

23\_ISA\_52\_13 **behold, my servant shall deal prudently, he shall be exalted And extolled, And be very high**

23\_ISA\_52\_14 **as Many were astonied at thee; his visage was So marred more than any man, And his form more than the sons of men:**
