[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_01 the word of the LORD came again unto me , saying ,](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_02 now , thou son of man , take up A lamentation for Tyrus ;](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_03 And say unto Tyrus , O thou that art situate at the entry of the sea , \[ which art \] A merchant of the people for Many isles , thus saith the LORD God ; O Tyrus , thou hast said , I \[ am \] of perfect beauty .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_04 thy borders \[ are \] in the midst of the seas , thy builders have perfected thy beauty .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_05 they have made all thy \[ ship \] boards of fir trees of Senir : they have taken cedars from Lebanon to make masts for thee .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_06 \[ of \] the oaks of Bashan have they made thine oars ; the company of the Ashurites have made thy benches \[ of \] ivory , \[ brought \] out of the isles of Chittim .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_07 fine linen with broidered work from Egypt was that which thou spreadest forth to be thy sail ; blue And purple from the isles of Elishah was that which covered thee .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_08 the inhabitants of Zidon And Arvad were thy mariners : thy wise \[ men \] , O Tyrus , \[ that \] were in thee , were thy pilots .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_09 the ancients of Gebal And the wise \[ men \] thereof were in thee thy calkers : all the ships of the sea with their mariners were in thee to Occupy thy merchandise .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_10 they of Persia And of Lud And of Phut were in thine army , thy men of war : they hanged the shield And helmet in thee ; they set forth thy comeliness .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_11 the men of Arvad with thine army \[ were \] upon thy walls round about , And the Gammadims were in thy towers : they hanged their shields upon thy walls round about ; they have made thy beauty perfect .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_12 Tarshish \[ was \] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of all \[ kind of \] riches ; with silver , iron , tin , And lead , they traded in thy fairs .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_13 Javan , Tubal , And Meshech , they \[ were \] thy merchants : they traded the persons of men And vessels of brass in thy market .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_14 they of the house of Togarmah traded in thy fairs with horses And horsemen And mules .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_15 the men of Dedan \[ were \] thy merchants ; Many isles \[ were \] the merchandise of thine hand : they brought thee \[ for \] A present horns of ivory And ebony .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_16 Syria \[ was \] thy merchant by reason of the multitude of the wares of thy making : they occupied in thy fairs with emeralds , purple , And broidered work , And fine linen , And coral , And agate .](#)

[26\\_EZE\\_27\\_17 Judah , And the land of Israel , they \[ were \] thy merchants : they traded in thy market wheat of Minnith , And Pannag , And honey , And oil , And balm .](#)

26\_EZE\_27\_18 Damascus [ was ] thy merchant in the multitude of the wares of thy making , for the multitude of all riches ; in the wine of Helbon , And white wool .

26\_EZE\_27\_19 Dan also And Javan going to And fro occupied in thy fairs : bright iron , cassia , And calamus , were in thy market .

26\_EZE\_27\_20 Dedan [ was ] thy merchant in precious clothes for chariots .

26\_EZE\_27\_21 Arabia , And all the princes of Kedar , they occupied with thee in lambs , And rams , And goats : in These [ were they ] thy merchants .

26\_EZE\_27\_22 the merchants of Sheba And Raamah , they [ were ] thy merchants : they occupied in thy fairs with chief of all spices , And with all precious stones , And gold .

26\_EZE\_27\_23 Haran , And Canneh , And Eden , the merchants of Sheba , Asshur , [ And ] Chilmad , [ were ] thy merchants .

26\_EZE\_27\_24 These [ were ] thy merchants in all sorts [ of things ] , in blue clothes , And broidered work , And in chests of rich apparel , bound with cords , And made of cedar , among thy merchandise .

26\_EZE\_27\_25 the ships of Tarshish did sing of thee in thy market : And thou wast replenished , And made very glorious in the midst of the seas .

26\_EZE\_27\_26 thy rowers have brought thee into great waters : the east wind hath broken thee in the midst of the seas .

26\_EZE\_27\_27 thy riches , And thy fairs , thy merchandise , thy mariners , And thy pilots , thy calkers , And the occupiers of thy merchandise , And all thy men of war , that [ are ] in thee , And in all thy company which [ Is ] in the midst of thee , shall fall into the midst of the seas in the day of thy ruin .

26\_EZE\_27\_28 the suburbs shall shake at the sound of the cry of thy pilots .

26\_EZE\_27\_29 And all that handle the oar , the mariners , [ And ] all the pilots of the sea , shall come down from their ships , they shall stand upon the land ;

26\_EZE\_27\_30 And shall cause their voice to be heard against thee , And shall cry bitterly , And shall cast up dust upon their heads , they shall wallow themselves in the ashes :

26\_EZE\_27\_31 And they shall make themselves utterly bald for thee , And gird them with sackcloth , And they shall weep for thee with bitterness of heart [ And ] bitter wailing .

26\_EZE\_27\_32 And in their wailing they shall take up A lamentation for thee , And lament over thee , [ saying ] , what [ city Is ] like Tyrus , like the destroyed in the midst of the sea ?

26\_EZE\_27\_33 when thy wares went forth out of the seas , thou filledst Many people ; thou didst enrich the kings of the earth with the multitude of thy riches And of thy merchandise .

26\_EZE\_27\_34 in the time [ when ] thou shalt be broken by the seas in the depths of the waters thy merchandise And all thy company in the midst of thee shall fall .

26\_EZE\_27\_35 all the inhabitants of the isles shall be astonished at thee , And their kings shall be sore afraid , they shall be troubled in [ their ] countenance .

26\_EZE\_27\_36 the merchants among the people shall hiss at thee ; thou shalt be A terror , And never [ shalt be ] any more .
