41\_MAR\_04\_01 And he began again to teach by the sea side : And there was gathered unto him A great multitude , So that he entered into A ship , And sat in the sea ; And the whole multitude was by the sea on the land .

41\_MAR\_04\_02 And he taught them Many things by parables , And said unto them in his doctrine ,

41\_MAR\_04\_03 hearken ; behold , there went out A sower to sow :

41\_MAR\_04\_04 And it came to pass , as he sowed , some fell by the way side , And the fowls of the air came And devoured it up .

41\_MAR\_04\_05 And some fell on stony ground , where it had not much earth ; And immediately it sprang up , because it had no depth of earth :

41\_MAR\_04\_06 but when the sun was up , it was scorched ; And because it had no root , it withered away .

41\_MAR\_04\_07 And some fell among thorns , And the thorns grew up , And choked it , And it yielded no fruit .

41\_MAR\_04\_08 And other fell on good ground , And did yield fruit that sprang up And increased ; And brought forth , some thirty , And some sixty , And some an hundred .

41\_MAR\_04\_09 And he said unto them , he that hath ears to hear , let him hear .

41\_MAR\_04\_10 And when he was alone , they that were about him with the twelve asked of him the parable .

41\_MAR\_04\_11 And he said unto them , unto you it Is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God : but unto them that are without , all [ These ] things are done in parables :

41\_MAR\_04\_12 that seeing they may see , And not perceive ; And hearing they may hear , And not understand ; lest at any time they should be converted , And [ their ] sins should be forgiven them .

41\_MAR\_04\_13 And he said unto them , know ye not this parable ? And how Then will ye know all parables ?

41\_MAR\_04\_14 the sower soweth the word .

41\_MAR\_04\_15 And These are they by the way side , where the word Is sown ; but when they have heard , Satan cometh immediately , And taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts .

41\_MAR\_04\_16 And These are they Likewise which are sown on stony ground ; who , when they have heard the word , immediately receive it with gladness ;

41\_MAR\_04\_17 And have no root in themselves , And So endure but for A time : Afterward , when affliction or persecution ariseth for the word's sake , immediately they are offended .

41\_MAR\_04\_18 And These are they which are sown among thorns ; such as hear the word ,

41\_MAR\_04\_19 And the cares of this world , And the deceitfulness of riches , And the lusts of other things entering in , choke the word , And it becometh unfruitful .

41\_MAR\_04\_20 And These are they which are sown on good ground ; such as hear the word , And receive [ it ] , And bring forth fruit , some thirtyfold , some sixty , And some an hundred .

41\_MAR\_04\_21 And he said unto them , Is A candle brought to be put under A bushel , or under A bed ? And not to be set on A candlestick ?

41\_MAR\_04\_22 for there Is nothing hid , which shall not be manifested ; neither was any thing kept secret , but that it should come abroad .

41\_MAR\_04\_23 if any man have ears to hear , let him hear .

41\_MAR\_04\_24 And he said unto them , take heed what ye hear : with what measure ye mete , it shall be measured to you : And unto you that hear shall more be given .

41\_MAR\_04\_25 for he that hath , to him shall be given : And he that hath not , from him shall be taken even that which he hath .

41\_MAR\_04\_26 And he said , So Is the kingdom of God , as if A man should cast seed into the ground ;

41\_MAR\_04\_27 And should Sleep , And rise night And day , And the seed should spring And grow up , he knoweth not how .

41\_MAR\_04\_28 for the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself ; first the blade , Then the ear , after that the full corn in the ear .

41\_MAR\_04\_29 but when the fruit Is brought forth , immediately he putteth in the sickle , because the harvest Is come .

41\_MAR\_04\_30 And he said , whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God ? or with what comparison shall we compare it ?

41\_MAR\_04\_31 [ it Is ] like A grain of mustard seed , which , when it Is sown in the earth , Is less than all the seeds that be in the earth :

41\_MAR\_04\_32 but when it Is sown , it groweth up , And becometh greater than all herbs , And shooteth out great branches ; So that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it .

41\_MAR\_04\_33 And with Many such parables spake he the word unto them , as they were able to hear [ it ] .

41\_MAR\_04\_34 but without A parable spake he not unto them : And when they were alone , he expounded all things to his disciples .

41\_MAR\_04\_35 And the same day , when the even was come , he saith unto them , let us pass over unto the other side .

41\_MAR\_04\_36 And when they had sent away the multitude , they took him even as he was in the ship . And there were also with him other little ships .

41\_MAR\_04\_37 And there arose A great storm of wind , And the waves beat into the ship , So that it was now full .

41\_MAR\_04\_38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship , asleep on A pillow : And they Awake him , And say unto him , master , carest thou not that we perish ?

41\_MAR\_04\_39 And he arose , And rebuked the wind , And said unto the sea , peace , be still . And the wind ceased , And there was A great calm .

41\_MAR\_04\_40 And he said unto them , why are ye So fearful ? how Is it that ye have no faith ?

41\_MAR\_04\_41 And they feared exceedingly , And said one to another , what manner of man Is this , that even the wind And the sea obey him ?
