41\_MAR\_06\_01 And he went out from thence, And came into his own country ; And his disciples follow him .

41\_MAR\_06\_02 And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue : And Many hearing [ him ] were astonished, saying, from whence hath this [ man ] These things ? And what wisdom [ Is ] this which Is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands ?

41\_MAR\_06\_03 Is not this the carpenter, the son of Mary, the brother of James, And Joses, And of Juda, And Simon ? And are not his sisters here with us ? And they were offended at him.

41\_MAR\_06\_04 but Jesus said unto them, A prophet Is not without honour, but in his own country, And among his own kin, And in his own house.

41\_MAR\_06\_05 And he could there do no mighty work, save that he laid his hands upon A few sick folk, And healed [ them ] .

41\_MAR\_06\_06 And he marvelled because of their unbelief. And he went round about the villages, teaching .

41\_MAR\_06\_07 And he called [ unto him ] the twelve, And began to send them forth by two And two ; And gave them power over unclean spirits ;

41\_MAR\_06\_08 And commanded them that they should take nothing for [ their ] journey, save A staff only ; no scrip, no bread, no money in [ their ] purse :

41\_MAR\_06\_09 but [ be ] shod with sandals ; And not put on two coats .

41\_MAR\_06\_10 And he said unto them, in what place soever ye enter into an house, there abide till ye Depart from that place .

41\_MAR\_06\_11 And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye Depart thence, shake off the dust under your feet for A testimony against them . Verily I say unto you, it shall be more tolerable for Sodom And Gomorrha in the day of judgment, than for that city .

41\_MAR\_06\_12 And they went out, And preached that men should repent .

41\_MAR\_06\_13 And they cast out Many devils, And anointed with oil Many that were sick, And healed [ them ] .

41\_MAR\_06\_14 And king Herod heard [ of him ] ; [ for his name was spread abroad : ] And he said, that John the Baptist was risen from the dead, And therefore mighty works do show forth themselves in him .

41\_MAR\_06\_15 others said, that it Is Elias . And others said, that it Is A prophet, or as one of the prophets .

41\_MAR\_06\_16 but when Herod heard [ thereof ], he said, it Is John, whom I beheaded : he Is risen from the dead .

41\_MAR\_06\_17 for Herod himself had sent forth And laid hold upon John, And bound him in prison for

Herodias' sake , his brother Philip's wife : for he had married her .

41\_MAR\_06\_18 for John had said unto Herod , it Is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife .

41\_MAR\_06\_19 therefore Herodias had A quarrel against him , And would have killed him ; but she could not :

41\_MAR\_06\_20 for Herod feared John , knowing that he was A just man And an holy , And observed him ; And when he heard him , he did Many things , And heard him gladly .

41\_MAR\_06\_21 And when A convenient day was come , that Herod on his birthday made A supper to his lords , high captains , And chief [ estates ] of Galilee ;

41\_MAR\_06\_22 And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in , And danced , And pleased Herod And them that sat with him , the king said unto the damsel , ask of me whatsoever thou wilt , And I will give [ it ] thee .

41\_MAR\_06\_23 And he sware unto her , whatsoever thou shalt ask of me , I will give [ it ] thee , unto the half of my kingdom .

41\_MAR\_06\_24 And she went forth , And said unto her mother , what shall I ask ? And she said , the head of John the Baptist .

41\_MAR\_06\_25 And she came in straightway with haste unto the king , And asked , saying , I will that thou give me by And by in A charger the head of John the Baptist .

41\_MAR\_06\_26 And the king was exceeding sorry ; [ yet ] for his oath's sake , And for their sakes which sat with him , he would not reject her .

41\_MAR\_06\_27 And immediately the king sent an executioner , And commanded his head to be brought : And he went And beheaded him in the prison ,

41\_MAR\_06\_28 And brought his head in A charger , And gave it to the damsel : And the damsel gave it to her mother .

41\_MAR\_06\_29 And when his disciples heard [ of it ] , they came And took up his corpse , And laid it in A tomb .

41\_MAR\_06\_30 And the apostles gathered themselves together unto Jesus , And told him all things , Both what they had done , And what they had taught .

41\_MAR\_06\_31 And he said unto them , come ye yourselves apart into A desert place , And rest A while : for there were Many coming And going , And they had no leisure So much as to eat .

41\_MAR\_06\_32 And they departed into A desert place by ship privately .

41\_MAR\_06\_33 And the people saw them departing , And Many knew him , And ran afoot thither out of all cities , And outwent them , And came together unto him .

41\_MAR\_06\_34 And Jesus , when he came out , saw much people , And was moved with compassion toward them , because they were as sheep not having A Shepherd : And he began to teach them Many things .

41\_MAR\_06\_35 And when the day was now far spent , his disciples came unto him , And said , this Is A desert place , And now the time [ Is ] far passed :

41\_MAR\_06\_36 send them away , that they may go into the country round about , And into the villages , And buy themselves bread : for they have nothing to eat .

41\_MAR\_06\_37 he answered And said unto them , give ye them to eat . And they say unto him , shall we go And buy two hundred pennyworth of bread , And give them to eat ?

41\_MAR\_06\_38 he saith unto them , how Many loaves have ye ? go And see . And when they knew , they say , five , And two fishes .

41\_MAR\_06\_39 And he commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass .

41\_MAR\_06\_40 And they sat down in ranks , by hundreds , And by fifties .

41\_MAR\_06\_41 And when he had taken the five loaves And the two fishes , he looked up to heaven , And blessed , And brake the loaves , And gave [ them ] to his disciples to set before them ; And the two fishes divided he among them all .

41\_MAR\_06\_42 And they did all eat , And were filled .

41\_MAR\_06\_43 And they took up twelve baskets full of the fragments , And of the fishes .

41\_MAR\_06\_44 And they that did eat of the loaves were about five thousand men .

41\_MAR\_06\_45 And straightway he constrained his disciples to get into the ship , And to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida , while he sent away the people .

41\_MAR\_06\_46 And when he had sent them away , he departed into A mountain to pray .

41\_MAR\_06\_47 And when even was come , the ship was in the midst of the sea , And he alone on the land .

41\_MAR\_06\_48 And he saw them toiling in rowing ; for the wind was contrary unto them : And about the fourth watch of the night he cometh unto them , walking upon the sea , And would have passed by them .

41\_MAR\_06\_49 but when they saw him walking upon the sea , they supposed it had been A spirit , And cried out :

41\_MAR\_06\_50 for they all saw him , And were troubled . And immediately he talked with them , And saith unto them , be of good cheer : it Is I ; be not afraid .

41\_MAR\_06\_51 And he went up unto them into the ship ; And the wind ceased : And they were sore amazed in themselves beyond measure , And wondered .

41\_MAR\_06\_52 for they considered not [ the miracle ] of the loaves : for their heart was hardened .

41\_MAR\_06\_53 And when they had passed over , they came into the land of Gennesaret , And drew to the shore .

41\_MAR\_06\_54 And when they were come out of the ship , straightway they knew him ,

41\_MAR\_06\_55 And ran through that whole region round about , And began to carry about in beds those that were sick , where they heard he was .

41\_MAR\_06\_56 And whithersoever he entered , into villages , or cities , or country , they laid the sick in the streets , And besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment : And as Many as

touched him were made whole.
