- 42_LUK_16_01 [And he said also unto his disciples, there was A certain rich man, which had A steward; And the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods.](#)
- 42_LUK_16_02 [And he called him, And said unto him, how Is it that I hear this of thee? give an account of thy stewardship; for thou mavest be no longer steward.](#)
- 42_LUK_16_03 [Then the steward said within himself, what shall I do? for my LORD taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed.](#)

- 42_LUK_16_10 [he that Is faithful in that which Is least Is faithful also in much: And he that Is unjust in the least Is unjust also in much.](#)
- 42_LUK_16_11 [if therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true \[riches \]?](#)
- 42_LUK_16_12 [And if ye have not been faithful in that which Is another man's, who shall give you that which Is your own?](#)
- 42_LUK_16_13 [no servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, And love the other; or else he will hold to the one, And despise the other. ye cannot serve God And mammon.](#)
