[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_01 And \[ Jesus \] entered And passed through Jericho .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_02 And , behold , \[ there was \] A man named Zacchaeus , which was the chief among the publicans , And he was rich .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_03 And he sought to see Jesus who he was ; And could not for the press , because he was little of stature .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_04 And he ran before , And climbed up into A sycamore tree to see him : for he was to pass that \[ way \] .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_05 And when Jesus came to the place , he looked up , And saw him , And said unto him , Zacchaeus , make haste , And come down ; for to day I must abide at thy house .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_06 And he made haste , And came down , And received him joyfully .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_07 And when they saw \[ it \] , they all murmured , saying , that he was gone to be guest with A man that Is A sinner .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_08 And Zacchaeus stood , And said unto the LORD ; behold , LORD , the half of my goods I give to the poor ; And if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation , I Restore \[ him \] fourfold .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_09 And Jesus said unto him , this day Is salvation come to this house , forsomuch as he also Is A son of Abraham .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_10 for the son of man Is come to seek And to save that which was lost .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_11 And as they heard These things , he added And spake A parable , because he was nigh to Jerusalem , And because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_12 he said therefore , A certain nobleman went into A far country to receive for himself A kingdom , And to Return .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_13 And he called his ten servants , And delivered them ten pounds , And said unto them , Occupy till I come .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_14 but his citizens hated him , And sent A message after him , saying , we will not have this \[ man \] to reign over us .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_15 And it came to pass , that when he was returned , having received the kingdom , Then he commanded These servants to be called unto him , to whom he had given the money , that he might know how much every man had gained by trading .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_16 Then came the first , saying , LORD , thy pound hath gained ten pounds .](#)

[42\\_LUK\\_19\\_17 And he said unto him , Well , thou good servant : because thou hast been faithful in A very little , have thou authority over ten cities .](#)

42\_LUK\_19\_18 And the second came , saying , LORD , thy pound hath gained five pounds .

42\_LUK\_19\_19 And he said Likewise to him , be thou also over five cities .

42\_LUK\_19\_20 And another came , saying , LORD , behold , [ here Is ] thy pound , which I have kept laid up in A napkin :

42\_LUK\_19\_21 for I feared thee , because thou art an austere man : thou takest up that thou layedst not down , And reapest that thou didst not sow .

42\_LUK\_19\_22 And he saith unto him , out of thine own mouth will I judge thee , [ thou ] wicked servant . thou knewest that I was an austere man , taking up that I laid not down , And reaping that I did not sow :

42\_LUK\_19\_23 Wherefore Then Gavest not thou my money into the bank , that at my coming I might have required mine own with usury ?

42\_LUK\_19\_24 And he said unto them that stood by , take from him the pound , And give [ it ] to him that hath ten pounds .

42\_LUK\_19\_25 [ And they said unto him , LORD , he hath ten pounds . ]

42\_LUK\_19\_26 for I say unto you , that unto every one which hath shall be given ; And from him that hath not , even that he hath shall be taken away from him .

42\_LUK\_19\_27 but those mine enemies , which would not that I should reign over them , bring hither , And slay [ them ] before me .

42\_LUK\_19\_28 And when he had thus spoken , he went before , ascending up to Jerusalem .

42\_LUK\_19\_29 And it came to pass , when he was come nigh to Bethphage And Bethany , at the mount called [ the mount ] of olives , he sent two of his disciples ,

42\_LUK\_19\_30 saying , go ye into the village over against [ you ] ; in the which at your entering ye shall find A colt tied , whereon yet never man sat : Loose him , And bring [ him hither ] .

42\_LUK\_19\_31 And if any man ask you , why do ye Loose [ him ] ? thus shall ye say unto him , because the LORD hath need of him .

42\_LUK\_19\_32 And they that were sent went their way , And found even as he had said unto them .

42\_LUK\_19\_33 And as they were loosing the colt , the owners thereof said unto them , why Loose ye the colt ?

42\_LUK\_19\_34 And they said , the LORD hath need of him .

42\_LUK\_19\_35 And they brought him to Jesus : And they cast their garments upon the colt , And they set Jesus thereon .

42\_LUK\_19\_36 And as he went , they spread their clothes in the way .

42\_LUK\_19\_37 And when he was come nigh , even now at the descent of the mount of olives , the whole multitude of the disciples began to Rejoice And praise God with A loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen ;

42\_LUK\_19\_38 saying , blessed [ be ] the king that cometh in the name of the LORD : peace in heaven ,

And glory in the highest .

42\_LUK\_19\_39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him , master , rebuke thy disciples .

42\_LUK\_19\_40 And he answered And said unto them , I tell you that , if These should hold their peace , the stones would immediately cry out .

42\_LUK\_19\_41 And when he was come near , he beheld the city , And wept over it ,

42\_LUK\_19\_42 saying , if thou hadst known , even thou , at least in this thy day , the things [ which belong ] unto thy peace ! but now they are hid from thine eyes .

42\_LUK\_19\_43 for the days shall come upon thee , that thine enemies shall cast A trench about thee , And compass thee round , And keep thee in on every side ,

42\_LUK\_19\_44 And shall lay thee even with the ground , And thy children within thee ; And they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another ; because thou knewest not the time of thy visitation .

42\_LUK\_19\_45 And he went into the temple , And began to cast out them that sold therein , And them that bought ;

42\_LUK\_19\_46 saying unto them , it Is written , my house Is the house of prayer : but ye have made it A den of thieves .

42\_LUK\_19\_47 And he taught daily in the temple . but the chief priests And the scribes And the chief of the people sought to destroy him ,

42\_LUK\_19\_48 And could not find what they might do : for all the people were very attentive to hear him .
