60\_IPE\_02\_02 [as newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby :](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_03 [if So be ye have tasted that the LORD \[ Is \] gracious.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_04 [to whom coming, \[ as unto \] A living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, \[ And \] precious,](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_05 [ye also, as lively stones, are built up A spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ,](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_12 [having your conversation honest among the Gentiles : that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by \[ your \] good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_13 [submit yourselves to every ordinance of man for the LORD's sake : whether it be to the king, as supreme ;](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_14 [or unto governors, as unto them that are sent by him for the punishment of evildoers, And for the praise of them that do Well.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_15 [for So Is the will of God, that with Well doing ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men :](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_16 [as free, And not using \[ your \] liberty for A cloak of maliciousness, but as the servants of God.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_17 [honour all \[ men \], love the brotherhood. Fear God, honour the king.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_18 [servants, \[ be \] subject to \[ your \] masters with all Fear ; not only to the good And gentle, but also to the froward.](#)

60\_IPE\_02\_20 [for what glory \[ Is it \], if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently ? but if, when ye do Well, And suffer \[ for it \], ye take it patiently, this \[ Is \] acceptable with God.](#)
