Abelbethmaachah and all <u>11_1KI_15_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

Abelmeholah even unto 11 1KI 04 12 # Baana the son of Ahilud; [to him pertained] Taanach and Megiddo, and all Bethshean, which [is] by Zartanah beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to Abelmeholah, [even] unto [the place that is] beyond Jokneam:

Abelmeholah shalt thou <u>11_1KI_19_16</u># And Jehu the son of Nimshi shalt thou anoint [to be] king over Israel: and Elisha the son of Shaphat of Abelmeholah shalt thou anoint [to be] prophet in thy room.

Babel and Erech <u>01_GEN_10_10</u># And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

Zerubbabel Jeshua Nehemiah <u>16 NEH 07 07</u> # Who came with Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Azariah, Raamiah, Nahamani, Mordecai, Bilshan, Mispereth, Bigvai, Nehum, Baanah. The number, [I say], of the men of the people of Israel [was this];

Zerubbabel Meshullam and <u>13_1CH_03_19</u> # And the sons of Pedaiah [were], Zerubbabel, and Shimei: and the sons of Zerubbabel; Meshullam, and Hananiah, and Shelomith their sister:

Zerubbabel my servant <u>37_HAG_02_23</u># In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, will I take thee, O Zerubbabel, my servant, the son of Shealtiel, saith the LORD, and will make thee as a signet: for I have chosen thee, saith the LORD of hosts.

Zerubbabel saith the <u>37_HAG_02_04</u> # Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith the LORD; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I [am] with you, saith the LORD of hosts:

Zorobabel which was 42_LUK_03_27 # Which was [the son] of Joanna, which was [the son] of Rhesa, which was [the son] of Zorobabel, which was [the son] of Salathiel, which was [the son] of Neri,

Zorobabel <u>40_MAT_01_12</u># And after they were brought to Babylon, Jechonias begat Salathiel; and Salathiel begat Zorobabel;
