Abi the daughter <u>12\_2KI\_18\_02</u> # Twenty and five years old was he when he began to reign; and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Abi, the daughter of Zachariah.

Abia and Abia <u>40\_MAT\_01\_07</u># And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

Abia and his <u>42\_LUK\_01\_05</u> # There was in the days of Herod, the king of Judaea, a certain priest named Zacharias, of the course of Abia: and his wife [was] of the daughters of Aaron, and her name [was] Elisabeth.

Abia begat Asa <u>40\_MAT\_01\_07</u># And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

Abia his son <u>13\_1CH\_03\_10</u> # And Solomon's son [was] Rehoboam, Abia his son, Asa his son, Jehoshaphat his son,

Abiah and Anathoth <u>13\_1CH\_07\_08</u># And the sons of Becher; Zemira, and Joash, and Eliezer, and Elioenai, and Omri, and Jerimoth, and Abiah, and Anathoth, and Alameth. All these [are] the sons of Becher.

Abiah Hezron's wife <u>13\_1CH\_02\_24</u> # And after that Hezron was dead in Calebephratah, then Abiah Hezron's wife bare him Ashur the father of Tekoa.

Abiah they were <u>09\_1SA\_08\_02</u> # Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah: [they were] judges in Beersheba.

Abiah <u>13\_1CH\_06\_28</u> # And the sons of Samuel; the firstborn Vashni, and Abiah.

Abialbon the Arbathite <u>10\_28A\_23\_31</u> # Abialbon the Arbathite, Azmaveth the Barhumite,

Abiasaph these are <u>02\_EXO\_06\_24</u> # And the sons of Korah; Assir, and Elkanah, and Abiasaph: these [are] the families of the Korhites.

Abiathar and before <u>13\_1CH\_24\_06</u> # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

Abiathar and the <u>13\_1CH\_27\_34</u> # And after Ahithophel [was] Jehoiada the son of Benaiah, and Abiathar: and the general of the king's army [was] Joab.

Abiathar brought thither <u>09\_18A\_30\_07</u># And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

Abiathar carried the <u>10\_2SA\_15\_29</u># Zadok therefore and Abiathar carried the ark of God again to Jerusalem: and they tarried there.

Abiathar escaped and <u>09\_1SA\_22\_20</u># And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named

Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

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Abiathar I knew <u>09\_1SA\_22\_22</u># And David said unto Abiathar, I knew [it] that day, when Doeg the Edomite [was] there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned [the death] of all the persons of thy father's house.

Abiathar showed David <u>09\_18A\_22\_21</u># And Abiathar showed David that Saul had slain the LORD'S priests.

Abiathar the high <u>41\_MAR\_02\_26</u> # How he went into the house of God in the days of Abiathar the high priest, and did eat the showbread, which is not lawful to eat but for the priests, and gave also to them which were with him?

Abiathar the priest <u>11\_1KI\_01\_07</u># And he conferred with Joab the son of Zeruiah, and with Abiathar the priest: and they following Adonijah helped [him].

Abiathar the priest <u>11\_1KI\_01\_19</u># And he hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the sons of the king, and Abiathar the priest, and Joab the captain of the host: but Solomon thy servant hath he not called.

Abiathar the priest <u>11\_1KI\_01\_25</u># For he is gone down this day, and hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the king's sons, and the captains of the host, and Abiathar the priest; and, behold, they eat and drink before him, and say, God save king Adonijah.

Abiathar were the <u>10\_2SA\_20\_25</u> # And Sheva [was] scribe: and Zadok and Abiathar [were] the priests:

Abiathar <u>11\_1KI\_02\_35</u># And the king put Benaiah the son of Jehoiada in his room over the host: and Zadok the priest did the king put in the room of Abiathar.

Abimelech and the <u>07\_JUD\_09\_23</u> # Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech:

Abimelech and the <u>07\_JUD\_09\_44</u> # And Abimelech, and the company that [was] with him, rushed forward, and stood in the entering of the gate of the city: and the two [other] companies ran upon all [the people] that [were] in the fields, and slew them.

Abimelech and who <u>07\_JUD\_09\_28</u> # And Gaal the son of Ebed said, Who [is] Abimelech, and who [is] Shechem, that we should serve him? [is] not [he] the son of Jerubbaal? and Zebul his officer? serve the men of Hamor the father of Shechem: for why should we serve him?

Abimelech because of <u>01\_GEN\_20\_18</u># For the LORD had fast closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech, because of Sarah Abraham's wife.

Abimelech because of <u>01\_GEN\_21\_25</u># And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Abimelech called Abraham <u>01\_GEN\_20\_09</u> # Then Abimelech called Abraham, and said unto him, What hast thou done unto us? and what have I offended thee, that thou hast brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? thou hast done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.

Abimelech called Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_26\_09</u> # And Abimelech called Isaac, and said, Behold, of a surety she [is] thy wife: and how saidst thou, She [is] my sister? And Isaac said unto him, Because I said, Lest I die for

Abimelech came unto <u>07\_JUD\_09\_52</u># And Abimelech came unto the tower, and fought against it, and went hard unto the door of the tower to burn it with fire.

Abimelech charged all <u>01\_GEN\_26\_11</u># And Abimelech charged all [his] people, saying, He that toucheth this man or his wife shall surely be put to death.

Abimelech chased him <u>07\_JUD\_09\_40</u> # And Abimelech chased him, and he fled before him, and many were overthrown [and] wounded, [even] unto the entering of the gate.

Abimelech dwelt at <u>07\_JUD\_09\_41</u> # And Abimelech dwelt at Arumah: and Zebul thrust out Gaal and his brethren, that they should not dwell in Shechem.

Abimelech for they <u>07\_JUD\_09\_03</u># And his mother's brethren spake of him in the ears of all the men of Shechem all these words: and their hearts inclined to follow Abimelech; for they said, He [is] our brother.

Abimelech fought against <u>07\_JUD\_09\_45</u> # And Abimelech fought against the city all that day; and he took the city, and slew the people that [was] therein, and beat down the city, and sowed it with salt.

Abimelech gat him <u>07\_JUD\_09\_48</u> # And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

Abimelech had not <u>01\_GEN\_20\_04</u># But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, Lord, wilt thou slay also a righteous nation?

Abimelech had reigned 07\_JUD\_09\_22 # When Abimelech had reigned three years over Israel,

Abimelech hired vain <u>07\_JUD\_09\_04</u> # And they gave him threescore and ten [pieces] of silver out of the house of Baalberith, wherewith Abimelech hired vain and light persons, which followed him.

Abimelech his brother <u>07\_JUD\_09\_21</u> # And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his brother.

Abimelech in a <u>01\_GEN\_20\_03</u># But God came to Abimelech in a dream by night, and said to him, Behold, thou [art but] a dead man, for the woman which thou hast taken; for she [is] a man's wife.

Abimelech Increase thine <u>07\_JUD\_09\_29</u> # And would to God this people were under my hand! then would I remove Abimelech. And he said to Abimelech, Increase thine army, and come out.

Abimelech king and <u>07\_JUD\_09\_16</u># Now therefore, if ye have done truly and sincerely, in that ye have made Abimelech king, and if ye have dealt well with Jerubbaal and his house, and have done unto him according to the deserving of his hands;

Abimelech king by <u>07\_JUD\_09\_06</u># And all the men of Shechem gathered together, and all the house of Millo, and went, and made Abimelech king, by the plain of the pillar that [was] in Shechem.

Abimelech king of <u>01\_GEN\_20\_02</u> # And Abraham said of Sarah his wife, She [is] my sister: and Abimelech king of Gerar sent, and took Sarah.

Abimelech king of <u>01\_GEN\_26\_01</u> # And there was a famine in the land, beside the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. And Isaac went unto Abimelech king of the Philistines unto Gerar.

Abimelech king of <u>01\_GEN\_26\_08</u># And it came to pass, when he had been there a long time, that Abimelech king of the Philistines looked out at a window, and saw, and, behold, Isaac [was] sporting with Rebekah his wife.

Abimelech privily saying <u>07\_JUD\_09\_31</u> # And he sent messengers unto Abimelech privily, saying, Behold, Gaal the son of Ebed and his brethren be come to Shechem; and, behold, they fortify the city against thee.

Abimelech rose early <u>01\_GEN\_20\_08</u> # Therefore Abimelech rose early in the morning, and called all his servants, and told all these things in their ears: and the men were sore afraid.

Abimelech rose up <u>01\_GEN\_21\_32</u> # Thus they made a covenant at Beersheba: then Abimelech rose up, and Phichol the chief captain of his host, and they returned into the land of the Philistines.

Abimelech rose up <u>07\_JUD\_09\_34</u># And Abimelech rose up, and all the people that [were] with him, by night, and they laid wait against Shechem in four companies.

Abimelech rose up <u>07\_JUD\_09\_35</u> # And Gaal the son of Ebed went out, and stood in the entering of the gate of the city: and Abimelech rose up, and the people that [were] with him, from lying in wait.

Abimelech said Behold <u>01\_GEN\_20\_15</u># And Abimelech said, Behold, my land [is] before thee: dwell where it pleaseth thee.

Abimelech said I <u>01\_GEN\_21\_26</u># And Abimelech said, I wot not who hath done this thing: neither didst thou tell me, neither yet heard I [of it], but to day.

Abimelech said unto <u>01\_GEN\_20\_10</u># And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What sawest thou, that thou hast done this thing?

Abimelech said unto <u>01\_GEN\_21\_29</u> # And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What [mean] these seven ewe lambs which thou hast set by themselves?

Abimelech said unto <u>01\_GEN\_26\_16</u># And Abimelech said unto Isaac, Go from us; for thou art much mightier than we.

Abimelech said What <u>01\_GEN\_26\_10</u># And Abimelech said, What [is] this thou hast done unto us? one of the people might lightly have lien with thy wife, and thou shouldest have brought guiltiness upon us.

Abimelech that all <u>07\_JUD\_09\_47</u># And it was told Abimelech, that all the men of the tower of Shechem were gathered together.

Abimelech that we <u>07\_JUD\_09\_38</u># Then said Zebul unto him, Where [is] now thy mouth, wherewith thou saidst, Who [is] Abimelech, that we should serve him? [is] not this the people that thou hast despised? go out, I pray now, and fight with them.

Abimelech the son <u>13\_1CH\_18\_16</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Abimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Shavsha was scribe;

Abimelech the son <u>10\_2SA\_11\_21</u> # Who smote Abimelech the son of Jerubbesheth? did not a woman cast a piece of a millstone upon him from the wall, that he died in Thebez? why went ye nigh the wall? then say thou, Thy servant Uriah the Hittite is dead also.

Abimelech the son <u>07\_JUD\_09\_01</u># And Abimelech the son of Jerubbaal went to Shechem unto his mother's brethren, and communed with them, and with all the family of the house of his mother's father, saying,

Abimelech the son <u>07\_JUD\_09\_18</u># And ye are risen up against my father's house this day, and have slain his sons, threescore and ten persons, upon one stone, and have made Abimelech, the son of his maidservant, king over the men of Shechem, because he [is] your brother;]

Abimelech their brother <u>07\_JUD\_09\_24</u> # That the cruelty [done] to the threescore and ten sons of Jerubbaal might come, and their blood be laid upon Abimelech their brother, which slew them; and upon the men of Shechem, which aided him in the killing of his brethren.

Abimelech there arose <u>07\_JUD\_10\_01</u># And after Abimelech there arose to defend Israel Tola the son of Puah the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar, and he dwelt in Shamir in mount Ephraim.

Abimelech to Thebez <u>07\_JUD\_09\_50</u># Then went Abimelech to Thebez, and encamped against Thebez, and took it.

Abimelech took an <u>07\_JUD\_09\_48</u># And Abimelech gat him up to mount Zalmon, he and all the people that [were] with him; and Abimelech took an ax in his hand, and cut down a bough from the trees, and took it, and laid [it] on his shoulder, and said unto the people that [were] with him, What ye have seen me do, make haste, [and] do as I [have done].

Abimelech took sheep <u>01\_GEN\_20\_14</u># And Abimelech took sheep, and oxen, and menservants, and womenservants, and gave [them] unto Abraham, and restored him Sarah his wife.

Abimelech was dead <u>07\_JUD\_09\_55</u> # And when the men of Israel saw that Abimelech was dead, they departed every man unto his place.

Abimelech went to <u>01\_GEN\_26\_26</u># Then Abimelech went to him from Gerar, and Ahuzzath one of his friends, and Phichol the chief captain of his army.

Abimelech which he <u>07\_JUD\_09\_56</u># Thus God rendered the wickedness of Abimelech, which he did unto his father, in slaying his seventy brethren:

Abimelech who drove <u>19\_PSA\_34\_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_08\_31</u> # And his concubine that [was] in Shechem, she also bare him a son, whose name he called Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_20</u> # But if not, let fire come out from Abimelech, and devour the men of Shechem, and the house of Millo; and let fire come out from the men of Shechem, and from the house of Millo, and devour Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_23</u> # Then God sent an evil spirit between Abimelech and the men of Shechem; and the men of Shechem dealt treacherously with Abimelech:

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_25</u> # And the men of Shechem set liers in wait for him in the top of the mountains, and they robbed all that came along that way by them: and it was told Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_27</u> # And they went out into the fields, and gathered their vineyards, and trode [the grapes], and made merry, and went into the house of their god, and did eat and drink, and cursed Abimelech.

Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_39</u> # And Gaal went out before the men of Shechem, and fought with Abimelech.

Abimelech 07\_JUD\_09\_42 # And it came to pass on the morrow, that the people went out into the field; and

Abimelech's head and <u>07\_JUD\_09\_53</u># And a certain woman cast a piece of a millstone upon Abimelech's head, and all to brake his skull.

Abimelech's servants had <u>01\_GEN\_21\_25</u> # And Abraham reproved Abimelech because of a well of water, which Abimelech's servants had violently taken away.

Abinadab and Eshbaal <u>13\_1CH\_08\_33</u># And Ner begat Kish, and Kish begat Saul, and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Abinadab and Eshbaal <u>13\_1CH\_09\_39</u> # And Ner begat Kish; and Kish begat Saul; and Saul begat Jonathan, and Malchishua, and Abinadab, and Eshbaal.

Abinadab and made <u>09\_1SA\_16\_08</u># Then Jesse called Abinadab, and made him pass before Samuel. And he said, Neither hath the LORD chosen this.

Abinadab and Malchishua <u>13\_1CH\_10\_02</u> # And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.

Abinadab drave the <u>10\_2SA\_06\_03</u> # And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that [was] in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.

Abinadab in all <u>11\_1KI\_04\_11</u># The son of Abinadab, in all the region of Dor; which had Taphath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

Abinadab in the <u>09\_1SA\_07\_01</u> # And the men of Kirjathjearim came, and fetched up the ark of the LORD, and brought it into the house of Abinadab in the hill, and sanctified Eleazar his son to keep the ark of the LORD.

Abinadab that was <u>10\_2SA\_06\_03</u># And they set the ark of God upon a new cart, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab that [was] in Gibeah: and Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, drave the new cart.

Abinadab the second <u>13\_1CH\_02\_13</u># And Jesse begat his firstborn Eliab, and Abinadab the second, and Shimma the third,

Abinadab which was <u>10\_2SA\_06\_04</u># And they brought it out of the house of Abinadab which [was] at Gibeah, accompanying the ark of God: and Ahio went before the ark.

inhabitants of Gebim <u>23\_ISA\_10\_31</u> # Madmenah is removed; the inhabitants of Gebim gather themselves to flee.

inhabitants of Gibeah <u>07\_JUD\_20\_15</u> # And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

inhabitants of Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_09\_03</u># And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,

inhabitants of Gibeon <u>06\_JOS\_11\_19</u># There was not a city that made peace with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all [other] they took in battle.

inhabitants of Gilead <u>11\_1KI\_17\_01</u># And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

Moabites heard that <u>12\_2KI\_03\_21</u># And when all the Moabites heard that the kings were come up to fight against them, they gathered all that were able to put on armour, and upward, and stood in the border.

Moabitess said unto <u>08\_RUT\_02\_02</u># And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after [him] in whose sight I shall find grace. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter.

Moabitess the wife <u>08\_RUT\_04\_05</u> # Then said Boaz, What day thou buyest the field of the hand of Naomi, thou must buy [it] also of Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of the dead, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance.

Moabitess the wife <u>08\_RUT\_04\_10</u> # Moreover Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of Mahlon, have I purchased to be my wife, to raise up the name of the dead upon his inheritance, that the name of the dead be not cut off from among his brethren, and from the gate of his place: ye [are] witnesses this day.

Moabitess <u>14\_2CH\_24\_26</u> # And these are they that conspired against him; Zabad the son of Shimeath an Ammonitess, and Jehozabad the son of Shimrith a Moabitess.

Moabitish damsel that <u>08\_RUT\_02\_06</u># And the servant that was set over the reapers answered and said, It [is] the Moabitish damsel that came back with Naomi out of the country of Moab:

Nedabiah <u>13\_1CH\_03\_18</u># Malchiram also, and Pedaiah, and Shenazar, Jecamiah, Hoshama, and Nedabiah.

Rechabites and speak <u>24\_JER\_35\_02</u> # Go unto the house of the Rechabites, and speak unto them, and bring them into the house of the LORD, into one of the chambers, and give them wine to drink.

Rechabites pots full <u>24\_JER\_35\_05</u> # And I set before the sons of the house of the Rechabites pots full of wine, and cups, and I said unto them, Drink ye wine.

Rechabites Thus saith <u>24\_JER\_35\_18</u> # And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because ye have obeyed the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he hath commanded you:

Rehabiah were very <u>13\_1CH\_23\_17</u> # And the sons of Eliezer [were], Rehabiah the chief. And Eliezer had none other sons; but the sons of Rehabiah were very many.

stability of thy <u>23\_ISA\_33\_06</u> # And wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of thy times, [and] strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD [is] his treasure.

Tabitha arise And <u>44\_ACT\_09\_40</u># But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning [him] to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up.

Tabitha which by <u>44\_ACT\_09\_36</u> # Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did.
