Ahab according to <u>12_2KI_10_30</u> # And the LORD said unto Jehu, Because thou hast done well in executing [that which is] right in mine eyes, [and] hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that [was] in mine heart, thy children of the fourth [generation] shall sit on the throne of Israel.

Ahab and all <u>11_1KI_22_39</u># Now the rest of the acts of Ahab, and all that he did, and the ivory house which he made, and all the cities that he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Ahab and also <u>14_2CH_21_13</u># But hast walked in the way of the kings of Israel, and hast made Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem to go a whoring, like to the whoredoms of the house of Ahab, and also hast slain thy brethren of thy father's house, [which were] better than thyself:

Ahab and did <u>12_2KI_08_27</u> # And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as [did] the house of Ahab: for he [was] the son in law of the house of Ahab.

Ahab and found <u>14_2CH_22_08</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahab and he <u>11_1KI_18_12</u># And it shall come to pass, [as soon as] I am gone from thee, that the spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and [so] when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.

Ahab and I <u>11_1KI_18_01</u># And it came to pass [after] many days, that the word of the LORD came to Elijah in the third year, saying, Go, show thyself unto Ahab; and I will send rain upon the earth.

Ahab and I <u>12_2KI_21_13</u> # And I will stretch over Jerusalem the line of Samaria, and the plummet of the house of Ahab: and I will wipe Jerusalem as [a man] wipeth a dish, wiping [it], and turning [it] upside down.

Ahab And there <u>11_1KI_18_02</u># And Elijah went to show himself unto Ahab. And [there was] a sore famine in Samaria.

Ahab and told <u>11_1KI_18_16</u># So Obadiah went to meet Ahab, and told him: and Ahab went to meet Elijah.

Ahab and ye <u>33_MIC_06_16</u># For the statutes of Omri are kept, and all the works of the house of Ahab, and ye walk in their counsels; that I should make thee a desolation, and the inhabitants thereof an hissing: therefore ye shall bear the reproach of my people.

Ahab Arise take <u>11_1KI_21_15</u># And it came to pass, when Jezebel heard that Naboth was stoned, and was dead, that Jezebel said to Ahab, Arise, take possession of the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, which he refused to give thee for money: for Naboth is not alive, but dead.

Ahab As the <u>11_1KI_17_01</u> # And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

Ahab at Jezreel <u>14_2CH_22_06</u> # And he returned to be healed in Jezreel because of the wounds which were given him at Ramah, when he fought with Hazael king of Syria. And Azariah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Jehoram the son of Ahab at Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahab began Ahaziah <u>12_2KI_09_29</u> # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Ahab began to <u>11_1KI_22_51</u># Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Ahab began to <u>12_2KI_03_01</u> # Now Jehoram the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the eighteenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned twelve years.

Ahab called Obadiah <u>11_1KI_18_03</u># And Ahab called Obadiah, which [was] the governor of [his] house. [Now Obadiah feared the LORD greatly:

Ahab came into <u>11_1KI_21_04</u># And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

Ahab did more <u>11_1KI_16_33</u># And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him.

Ahab for he <u>14_2CH_21_06</u> # And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, like as did the house of Ahab: for he had the daughter of Ahab to wife: and he wrought [that which was] evil in the eyes of the LORD.

Ahab for he <u>12_2KI_08_27</u> # And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as [did] the house of Ahab: for he [was] the son in law of the house of Ahab.

Ahab for his <u>14_2CH_22_03</u># He also walked in the ways of the house of Ahab: for his mother was his counsellor to do wickedly.

Ahab for the <u>12_2KI_08_18</u># And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, as did the house of Ahab: for the daughter of Ahab was his wife: and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.

Ahab for the <u>12_2KI_10_10</u> # Know now that there shall fall unto the earth nothing of the word of the LORD, which the LORD spake concerning the house of Ahab: for the LORD hath done [that] which he spake by his servant Elijah.

Ahab for they <u>14_2CH_22_04</u> # Wherefore he did evil in the sight of the LORD like the house of Ahab: for they were his counsellors after the death of his father to his destruction.

Ahab Get thee <u>11_1KI_18_41</u># And Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for [there is] a sound of abundance of rain.

Ahab had seventy <u>12_2KI_10_01</u> # And Ahab had seventy sons in Samaria. And Jehu wrote letters, and sent to Samaria, unto the rulers of Jezreel, to the elders, and to them that brought up Ahab's [children], saying,

Ahab heard that <u>11_1KI_21_16</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab heard that Naboth was dead, that Ahab rose up to go down to the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite, to take possession of it.

Ahab heard those <u>11_1KI_21_27</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab heard those words, that he rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his flesh, and fasted, and lay in sackcloth, and went softly.

Ahab him that <u>11_1KI_21_21</u># Behold, I will bring evil upon thee, and will take away thy posterity, and will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel,

Ahab him that <u>12_2KI_09_08</u># For the whole house of Ahab shall perish: and I will cut off from Ahab him that pisseth against the wall, and him that is shut up and left in Israel:

Ahab his father <u>12_2KI_09_25</u> # Then said [Jehu] to Bidkar his captain, Take up, [and] cast him in the portion of the field of Naboth the Jezreelite: for remember how that, when I and thou rode together after Ahab his father, the LORD laid this burden upon him;

Ahab his son <u>11_1KI_16_28</u># So Omri slept with his fathers, and was buried in Samaria: and Ahab his son reigned in his stead.

Ahab humbleth himself <u>11_1KI_21_29</u># Seest thou how Ahab humbleth himself before me? because he humbleth himself before me, I will not bring the evil in his days: [but] in his son's days will I bring the evil upon his house.

Ahab I will <u>11_1KI_20_34</u># And [Benhadad] said unto him, The cities, which my father took from thy father, I will restore; and thou shalt make streets for thee in Damascus, as my father made in Samaria. Then [said Ahab], I will send thee away with this covenant. So he made a covenant with him, and sent him away.

Ahab in Jezreel <u>12_2KI_08_29</u> # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahab in Jezreel <u>12_2KI_10_11</u># So Jehu slew all that remained of the house of Ahab in Jezreel, and all his great men, and his kinsfolks, and his priests, until he left him none remaining.

Ahab in Samaria <u>12_2KI_10_17</u># And when he came to Samaria, he slew all that remained unto Ahab in Samaria, till he had destroyed him, according to the saying of the LORD, which he spake to Elijah.

Ahab in the <u>11_1KI_21_24</u># Him that dieth of Ahab in the city the dogs shall eat; and him that dieth in the field shall the fowls of the air eat.

Ahab killed sheep <u>14_2CH_18_02</u> # And after [certain] years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that [he had] with him, and persuaded him to go up [with him] to Ramothgilead.

Ahab king of <u>11_1KI_20_02</u># And he sent messengers to Ahab king of Israel into the city, and said unto him, Thus saith Benhadad,

Ahab king of <u>11_1KI_20_13</u># And, behold, there came a prophet unto Ahab king of Israel, saying, Thus saith the LORD, Hast thou seen all this great multitude? behold, I will deliver it into thine hand this day; and thou shalt know that I [am] the LORD.

Ahab king of <u>11_1KI_21_01</u># And it came to pass after these things, [that] Naboth the Jezreelite had a vineyard, which [was] in Jezreel, hard by the palace of Ahab king of Samaria.

Ahab king of <u>11_1KI_21_18</u># Arise, go down to meet Ahab king of Israel, which [is] in Samaria: behold, [he is] in the vineyard of Naboth, whither he is gone down to possess it.

Ahab king of <u>11_1KI_22_41</u># And Jehoshaphat the son of Asa began to reign over Judah in the fourth year of Ahab king of Israel.

Ahab king of <u>14_2CH_18_03</u># And Ahab king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat king of Judah, Wilt thou go with me to Ramothgilead? And he answered him, I [am] as thou [art], and my people as thy people; and [we will be] with thee in the war.

Ahab king of <u>14_2CH_18_19</u># And the LORD said, Who shall entice Ahab king of Israel, that he may go up and fall at Ramothgilead? And one spake saying after this manner, and another saying after that manner.

Ahab king of <u>14_2CH_22_05</u># He walked also after their counsel, and went with Jehoram the son of Ahab king of Israel to war against Hazael king of Syria at Ramothgilead: and the Syrians smote Joram.

Ahab king of <u>12_2KI_08_16</u># And in the fifth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel, Jehoshaphat [being] then king of Judah, Jehoram the son of Jehoshaphat king of Judah began to reign.

Ahab king of <u>12_2KI_08_25</u># In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Ahab king of <u>12_2KI_21_03</u># For he built up again the high places which Hezekiah his father had destroyed; and he reared up altars for Baal, and made a grove, as did Ahab king of Israel; and worshipped all the host of heaven, and served them.

Ahab like the <u>12_2KI_09_09</u> # And I will make the house of Ahab like the house of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and like the house of Baasha the son of Ahijah:

Ahab to the <u>11_1KI_18_46</u># And the hand of the LORD was on Elijah; and he girded up his loins, and ran before Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel.

Ahab to the <u>12_2KI_08_28</u> # And he went with Joram the son of Ahab to the war against Hazael king of Syria in Ramothgilead; and the Syrians wounded Joram.

Ahab to wife <u>14_2CH_21_06</u> # And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, like as did the house of Ahab: for he had the daughter of Ahab to wife: and he wrought [that which was] evil in the eyes of the

LORD.

Ahab told Jezebel <u>11_1KI_19_01</u># And Ahab told Jezebel all that Elijah had done, and withal how he had slain all the prophets with the sword.

Ahab unto Jehoshaphat <u>11_1KI_22_49</u> # Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not.

Ahab was dead <u>12_2KI_03_05</u># But it came to pass, when Ahab was dead, that the king of Moab rebelled against the king of Israel.

Ahab was his <u>12_2KI_08_18</u> # And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, as did the house of Ahab: for the daughter of Ahab was his wife: and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.

Ahab went one <u>11_1KI_18_06</u># So they divided the land between them to pass throughout it: Ahab went one way by himself, and Obadiah went another way by himself.

Ahab went to <u>11_1KI_18_16</u># So Obadiah went to meet Ahab, and told him: and Ahab went to meet Elijah.

Ahab went up <u>11_1KI_18_42</u># So Ahab went up to eat and to drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; and he cast himself down upon the earth, and put his face between his knees,

Ahab which did <u>11_1KI_21_25</u># But there was none like unto Ahab, which did sell himself to work wickedness in the sight of the LORD, whom Jezebel his wife stirred up.

Ahab whom the 24_JER_29_22 # And of them shall be taken up a curse by all the captivity of Judah which [are] in Babylon, saying, The LORD make thee like Zedekiah and like Ahab, whom the king of Babylon roasted in the fire;

Ahab <u>14_2CH_18_01</u># Now Jehoshaphat had riches and honour in abundance, and joined affinity with Ahab.

Ahab <u>14_2CH_22_07</u> # And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Ahab <u>12_2KI_01_01</u># Then Moab rebelled against Israel after the death of Ahab.

Ahab <u>12_2KI_08_27</u> # And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as [did] the house of Ahab: for he [was] the son in law of the house of Ahab.

Ahab's children saying <u>12_2KI_10_01</u># And Ahab had seventy sons in Samaria. And Jehu wrote letters, and sent to Samaria, unto the rulers of Jezreel, to the elders, and to them that brought up Ahab's [children], saying,

Ahab's name and <u>11_1KI_21_08</u># So she wrote letters in Ahab's name, and sealed [them] with his seal, and sent the letters unto the elders and to the nobles that [were] in his city, dwelling with Naboth.

Dizahab <u>05_DEU_01_01</u> # These [be] the words which Moses spake unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain over against the Red [sea], between Paran, and Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

Mezahab <u>13_1CH_01_50</u> # And when Baalhanan was dead, Hadad reigned in his stead: and the name of his city [was] Pai; and his wife's name [was] Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab.

Mezahab <u>01_GEN_36_39</u> # And Baalhanan the son of Achbor died, and Hadar reigned in his stead: and the name of his city [was] Pau; and his wife's name [was] Mehetabel, the daughter of Matred, the daughter of Mezahab.

Rahab and Babylon <u>19_PSA_87_04</u> # I will make mention of Rahab and Babylon to them that know me: behold Philistia, and Tyre, with Ethiopia; this [man] was born there.

Rahab and her <u>06_JOS_06_23</u> # And the young men that were spies went in, and brought out Rahab, and her father, and her mother, and her brethren, and all that she had; and they brought out all her kindred, and left them without the camp of Israel.

Rahab and lodged <u>06_JOS_02_01</u> # And Joshua the son of Nun sent out of Shittim two men to spy secretly, saying, Go view the land, even Jericho. And they went, and came into an harlot's house, named Rahab, and lodged there.

Rahab and wounded <u>23_ISA_51_09</u> # Awake, awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old. [Art] thou not it that hath cut Rahab, [and] wounded the dragon?

Rahab in pieces <u>19_PSA_89_10</u># Thou hast broken Rahab in pieces, as one that is slain; thou hast scattered thine enemies with thy strong arm.

Rahab perished not <u>58_HEB_11_31</u># By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

Rahab saying Bring <u>06_JOS_02_03</u> # And the king of Jericho sent unto Rahab, saying, Bring forth the men that are come to thee, which are entered into thine house: for they be come to search out all the country.

Rahab the harlot <u>59_JAM_02_25</u># Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent [them] out another way?

Rahab the harlot <u>06_JOS_06_17</u> # And the city shall be accursed, [even] it, and all that [are] therein, to the LORD: only Rahab the harlot shall live, she and all that [are] with her in the house, because she hid the messengers that we sent.

Rahab the harlot <u>06_JOS_06_25</u> # And Joshua saved Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household, and all that she had; and she dwelleth in Israel [even] unto this day; because she hid the messengers, which Joshua sent to spy out Jericho.
