Ahaz and Hezekiah <u>28_HOS_01_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beeri, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Ahaz and Hezekiah <u>23_ISA_01_01</u> # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Ahaz and Hezekiah <u>33_MIC_01_01</u> # The word of the LORD that came to Micah the Morasthite in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, which he saw concerning Samaria and Jerusalem.

Ahaz begat Jarah <u>13_1CH_09_42</u># And Ahaz begat Jarah; and Jarah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza;

Ahaz begat Jehoadah <u>13_1CH_08_36</u># And Ahaz begat Jehoadah; and Jehoadah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza,

Ahaz but could <u>12_2KI_16_05</u># Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

Ahaz came from <u>12_2KI_16_11</u># And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz commanded Urijah <u>12_2KI_16_15</u> # And king Ahaz commanded Urijah the priest, saying, Upon the great altar burn the morning burnt offering, and the evening meat offering, and the king's burnt sacrifice, and his meat offering, with the burnt offering of all the people of the land, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings; and sprinkle upon it all the blood of the burnt offering, and all the blood of the sacrifice: and the brazen altar shall be for me to inquire [by].

Ahaz commanded <u>12_2KI_16_16</u># Thus did Urijah the priest, according to all that king Ahaz commanded.

Ahaz cut off <u>12_2KI_16_17</u> # And king Ahaz cut off the borders of the bases, and removed the laver from off them; and took down the sea from off the brazen oxen that [were] under it, and put it upon a pavement of stones.

Ahaz died was <u>23_ISA_14_28</u># In the year that king Ahaz died was this burden.

Ahaz gathered together <u>14_2CH_28_24</u> # And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem.

Ahaz had sent <u>12_2KI_16_11</u># And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz his son <u>13_1CH_03_13</u> # Ahaz his son, Hezekiah his son, Manasseh his son,

Ahaz his son <u>14_2CH_27_09</u> # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz his son <u>12_2KI_15_38</u># And Jotham slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz in his <u>14_2CH_29_19</u> # Moreover all the vessels, which king Ahaz in his reign did cast away in his transgression, have we prepared and sanctified, and, behold, they [are] before the altar of the LORD.

Ahaz king of <u>14_2CH_28_19</u> # For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD.

Ahaz king of <u>12_2KI_17_01</u># In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years.

Ahaz king of <u>12_2KI_18_01</u># Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign.

Ahaz said I 23_ISA_07_12 # But Ahaz said, I will not ask, neither will I tempt the LORD.

Ahaz saying <u>23_ISA_07_10</u> # Moreover the LORD spake again unto Ahaz, saying,

Ahaz send unto <u>14_2CH_28_16</u># At that time did king Ahaz send unto the kings of Assyria to help him.

Ahaz sent messengers <u>12_2KI_16_07</u># So Ahaz sent messengers to Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, saying, I [am] thy servant and thy son: come up, and save me out of the hand of the king of Syria, and out of the hand of the king of Israel, which rise up against me.

Ahaz sent to <u>12_2KI_16_10</u> # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Ahaz slept with <u>14_2CH_28_27</u> # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz slept with <u>12_2KI_16_20</u> # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz ten degrees 23_ISA_38_08 # Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

Ahaz the son <u>12_2KI_16_01</u># In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.

Ahaz the son 23_ISA_07_01 # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Ahaz thou and <u>23_ISA_07_03</u># Then said the LORD unto Isaiah, Go forth now to meet Ahaz, thou, and Shearjashub thy son, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool in the highway of the fuller's field;

Ahaz took away <u>14_2CH_28_21</u># For Ahaz took away a portion [out] of the house of the LORD, and [out] of the house of the king, and of the princes, and gave [it] unto the king of Assyria: but he helped him not.

Ahaz took the <u>12_2KI_16_08</u># And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent [it for] a present to the king of Assyria.

Ahaz was twenty <u>14_2CH_28_01</u> # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

Ahaz went to <u>12_2KI_16_10</u># And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Ahaz when he <u>12_2KI_16_02</u> # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

Ahaz which he <u>12_2KI_16_19</u># Now the rest of the acts of Ahaz which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Ahaz which the <u>12_2KI_23_12</u> # And the altars that [were] on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake [them] down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron.

Ahaz <u>13_1CH_08_35</u> # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tarea, and Ahaz.

Ahaz <u>13_1CH_09_41</u># And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tahrea, [and Ahaz].

Ahaz <u>14_2CH_28_22</u># And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this [is that] king Ahaz.

Ahaz <u>12_2KI_20_11</u> # And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

Ahaziah and stole <u>14_2CH_22_11</u> # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah and stole <u>12_2KI_11_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah and they <u>14_2CH_22_09</u> # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah and we <u>12_2KI_10_13</u># Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah at Bethshemesh <u>12_2KI_14_13</u> # And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Ahaziah fell down <u>12_2KI_01_02</u># And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that [was] in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of Baalzebub the

god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.

Ahaziah had no <u>14_2CH_22_09</u> # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah he slew <u>14_2CH_22_08</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah hid him <u>14_2CH_22_11</u># But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah his fathers <u>12_2KI_12_18</u> # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Ahaziah his son <u>13_1CH_03_11</u># Joram his son, Ahaziah his son, Joash his son,

Ahaziah his son <u>11_1KI_22_40</u># So Ahab slept with his fathers; and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his son <u>12_2KI_08_24</u> # And Joram slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his youngest <u>14_2CH_22_01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah king of <u>14_2CH_20_35</u> # And after this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah join himself with Ahaziah king of Israel, who did very wickedly:

Ahaziah king of <u>12_2KI_09_16</u># So Jehu rode in a chariot, and went to Jezreel; for Joram lay there. And Ahaziah king of Judah was come down to see Joram.

Ahaziah king of <u>12_2KI_09_21</u> # And Joram said, Make ready. And his chariot was made ready. And Joram king of Israel and Ahaziah king of Judah went out, each in his chariot, and they went out against Jehu, and met him in the portion of Naboth the Jezreelite.

Ahaziah king of <u>12_2KI_10_13</u># Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah king of <u>12_2KI_13_01</u> # In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Ahaziah saw that <u>14_2CH_22_10</u> # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Ahaziah saw that <u>12_2KI_11_01</u># And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

Ahaziah that ministered <u>14_2CH_22_08</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah the king <u>12_2KI_09_27</u> # But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

Ahaziah the LORD <u>14_2CH_20_37</u># Then Eliezer the son of Dodavah of Mareshah prophesied against Jehoshaphat, saying, Because thou hast joined thyself with Ahaziah, the LORD hath broken thy works. And the ships were broken, that they were not able to go to Tarshish.

Ahaziah the son <u>11_1KI_22_49</u># Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not.

Ahaziah the son <u>11_1KI_22_51</u># Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Ahaziah the son <u>14_2CH_22_01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah the son <u>12_2KI_08_25</u># In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Ahaziah the son <u>12_2KI_08_29</u> # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahaziah There is <u>12_2KI_09_23</u># And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Ahaziah to reign <u>12_2KI_09_29</u> # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Ahaziah took Joash <u>12_2KI_11_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah was of <u>14_2CH_22_07</u> # And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Ahaziah when he <u>14_2CH_22_02</u># Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

Ahaziah when he <u>12_2KI_08_26</u> # Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Ahaziah which he <u>12_2KI_01_18</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Ahaziah which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Ahaziah <u>12_2KI_09_23</u> # And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Jahaz and fought <u>07_JUD_11_20</u># But Sihon trusted not Israel to pass through his coast: but Sihon gathered all his people together, and pitched in Jahaz, and fought against Israel.

Jahaz <u>05_DEU_02_32</u># Then Sihon came out against us, he and all his people, to fight at Jahaz.

Jahaza and Kedemoth <u>06_JOS_13_18</u># And Jahaza, and Kedemoth, and Mephaath,

Jahazah and upon <u>24_JER_48_21</u># And judgment is come upon the plain country; upon Holon, and upon Jahazah, and upon Mephaath,

Jahazah with her <u>06_JOS_21_36</u># And out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer with her suburbs, and Jahazah with her suburbs,

Jahaziah the son <u>15_EZR_10_15</u># Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this [matter]: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.

Jahaziel and Johanan <u>13_1CH_12_04</u> # And Ismaiah the Gibeonite, a mighty man among the thirty, and over the thirty; and Jeremiah, and Jahaziel, and Johanan, and Josabad the Gederathite,

Jahaziel and with <u>15_EZR_08_05</u># Of the sons of Shechaniah; the son of Jahaziel, and with him three hundred males.

Jahaziel the priests <u>13_1CH_16_06</u># Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.

Jahaziel the son <u>14_2CH_20_14</u> # Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation;

Jahaziel the third <u>13_1CH_23_19</u> # Of the sons of Hebron; Jeriah the first, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, and Jekameam the fourth.

Jahaziel the third <u>13_1CH_24_23</u> # And the sons [of Hebron]; Jeriah [the first], Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, Jekameam the fourth.

Jehoahaz and all <u>12_2KI_13_08</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoahaz, and all that he did, and his might, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Jehoahaz at Bethshemesh <u>14_2CH_25_23</u> # And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jehoahaz away and <u>12_2KI_23_34</u># And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt,

and died there.

Jehoahaz king of <u>14_2CH_25_25</u> # And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Jehoahaz king of <u>12_2KI_14_01</u># In the second year of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel reigned Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah.

Jehoahaz king of <u>12_2KI_14_17</u># And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Jehoahaz slept with <u>12_2KI_13_09</u> # And Jehoahaz slept with his fathers; and they buried him in Samaria: and Joash his son reigned in his stead.

Jehoahaz son of <u>12_2KI_14_08</u># Then Amaziah sent messengers to Jehoash, the son of Jehoahaz son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us look one another in the face.

Jehoahaz the son <u>14_2CH_25_17</u> # Then Amaziah king of Judah took advice, and sent to Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, the son of Jeho, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us see one another in the face.

Jehoahaz the son <u>14_2CH_36_01</u># Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

Jehoahaz the son <u>12_2KI_13_01</u># In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Jehoahaz the son <u>12_2KI_23_30</u> # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

Jehoahaz the youngest <u>14_2CH_21_17</u> # And they came up into Judah, and brake into it, and carried away all the substance that was found in the king's house, and his sons also, and his wives; so that there was never a son left him, save Jehoahaz, the youngest of his sons.
