

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Ahaziah and stole <u>14\_2CH\_22\_11</u> # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah and stole <u>12\_2KI\_11\_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah and they <u>14\_2CH\_22\_09</u> # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah and we <u>12\_2KI\_10\_13</u># Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah at Bethshemesh <u>12\_2KI\_14\_13</u># And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Ahaziah fell down <u>12\_2KI\_01\_02</u> # And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that [was] in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of Baalzebub the god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.

Ahaziah had no <u>14\_2CH\_22\_09</u> # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria, ] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah he slew <u>14\_2CH\_22\_08</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah hid him <u>14\_2CH\_22\_11</u># But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah his fathers <u>12\_2KI\_12\_18</u> # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Ahaziah his son <u>13\_1CH\_03\_11</u> # Joram his son, Ahaziah his son, Joash his son,

Ahaziah his son <u>11\_1KI\_22\_40</u># So Ahab slept with his fathers; and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his son <u>12\_2KI\_08\_24</u> # And Joram slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his youngest <u>14\_2CH\_22\_01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah king of <u>14\_2CH\_20\_35</u> # And after this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah join himself with Ahaziah king of Israel, who did very wickedly:

Ahaziah king of <u>12\_2KI\_09\_16</u># So Jehu rode in a chariot, and went to Jezreel; for Joram lay there. And Ahaziah king of Judah was come down to see Joram.

Ahaziah king of <u>12\_2KI\_09\_21</u> # And Joram said, Make ready. And his chariot was made ready. And Joram king of Israel and Ahaziah king of Judah went out, each in his chariot, and they went out against Jehu, and met him in the portion of Naboth the Jezreelite.

Ahaziah king of <u>12\_2KI\_10\_13</u> # Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah king of <u>12\_2KI\_13\_01</u># In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Ahaziah saw that <u>14\_2CH\_22\_10</u> # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Ahaziah saw that <u>12\_2KI\_11\_01</u># And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

Ahaziah that ministered <u>14\_2CH\_22\_08</u> # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah the king <u>12\_2KI\_09\_27</u># But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

Ahaziah the LORD <u>14\_2CH\_20\_37</u># Then Eliezer the son of Dodavah of Mareshah prophesied against Jehoshaphat, saying, Because thou hast joined thyself with Ahaziah, the LORD hath broken thy works. And the ships were broken, that they were not able to go to Tarshish.

Ahaziah the son <u>11\_1KI\_22\_49</u># Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not.

Ahaziah the son <u>11\_1KI\_22\_51</u># Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Ahaziah the son <u>14\_2CH\_22\_01</u> # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah the son <u>12\_2KI\_08\_25</u> # In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Ahaziah the son <u>12\_2KI\_08\_29</u># And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahaziah There is <u>12\_2KI\_09\_23</u># And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Ahaziah to reign <u>12\_2KI\_09\_29</u> # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Ahaziah took Joash <u>12\_2KI\_11\_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah was of <u>14\_2CH\_22\_07</u># And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Ahaziah when he <u>14\_2CH\_22\_02</u># Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

Ahaziah when he <u>12\_2KI\_08\_26</u># Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Ahaziah which he <u>12\_2KI\_01\_18</u> # Now the rest of the acts of Ahaziah which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Ahaziah <u>12\_2KI\_09\_23</u> # And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Jahaziah the son <u>15\_EZR\_10\_15</u> # Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this [matter]: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.
