

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Ahinoam of Jezreel <u>09_1SA_25_43</u> # David also took Ahinoam of Jezreel; and they were also both of them his wives.

Ahinoam the daughter <u>09_1SA_14_50</u># And the name of Saul's wife [was] Ahinoam, the daughter of Ahimaaz: and the name of the captain of his host [was] Abner, the son of Ner, Saul's uncle.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>13_1CH_03_01</u> # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>09_18A_27_03</u># And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>09_1SA_30_05</u># And David's two wives were taken captives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the wife of Nabal the Carmelite.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>10_2SA_02_02</u># So David went up thither, and his two wives also, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail Nabal's wife the Carmelite.

Ahinoam the Jezreelitess <u>10_2SA_03_02</u># And unto David were sons born in Hebron: and his firstborn was Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess;
