Adaiah and Beraiah <u>13\_1CH\_08\_21</u> # And Adaiah, and Beraiah, and Shimrath, the sons of Shimhi;

Adaiah and Elishaphat <u>14\_2CH\_23\_01</u> # And in the seventh year Jehoiada strengthened himself, and took the captains of hundreds, Azariah the son of Jeroham, and Ishmael the son of Jehohanan, and Azariah the son of Obed, and Maaseiah the son of Adaiah, and Elishaphat the son of Zichri, into covenant with him.

Adaiah Jashub and <u>15\_EZR\_10\_29</u># And of the sons of Bani; Meshullam, Malluch, and Adaiah, Jashub, and Sheal, and Ramoth.

Adaiah of Boscath <u>12\_2KI\_22\_01</u> # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath.

Adaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_12</u> # And Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchijah, and Maasiai the son of Adiel, the son of Jahzerah, the son of Meshullam, the son of Meshillemith, the son of Immer;

Adaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_05</u># And Maaseiah the son of Baruch, the son of Colhozeh, the son of Hazaiah, the son of Joiarib, the son of Zechariah, the son of Shiloni.

Adaiah the son <u>16 NEH\_11\_12</u># And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

Adaiah <u>13\_1CH\_06\_41</u># The son of Ethni, the son of Zerah, the son of Adaiah,

Adaiah <u>15\_EZR\_10\_39</u> # And Shelemiah, and Nathan, and Adaiah,

Aiah and Anah <u>13\_1CH\_01\_40</u># The sons of Shobal; Alian, and Manahath, and Ebal, Shephi, and Onam. And the sons of Zibeon; Aiah, and Anah.

Aiah and Ishbosheth <u>10\_2SA\_03\_07</u> # And Saul had a concubine, whose name [was] Rizpah, the daughter of Aiah: and [Ishbosheth] said to Abner, Wherefore hast thou gone in unto my father's concubine?

Aiah the concubine <u>10\_2SA\_21\_11</u># And it was told David what Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, the concubine of Saul, had done.

Asaiah and Adiel <u>13\_1CH\_04\_36</u># And Elioenai, and Jaakobah, and Jeshohaiah, and Asaiah, and Adiel, and Jesimiel, and Benaiah,

Asaiah and Joel <u>13\_1CH\_15\_11</u># And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites, for Uriel, Asaiah, and Joel, Shemaiah, and Eliel, and Amminadab,

Asaiah his son <u>13\_1CH\_06\_30</u># Shimea his son, Haggiah his son, Asaiah his son.

Asaiah the chief <u>13\_1CH\_15\_06</u># Of the sons of Merari; Asaiah the chief, and his brethren two hundred and twenty:

Asaiah the firstborn <u>13\_1CH\_09\_05</u># And of the Shilonites; Asaiah the firstborn, and his sons.

Athaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

Benaiah also and <u>13\_1CH\_16\_06</u># Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.

Benaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_11\_22</u> # Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man of Kabzeel, who had done many acts; he slew two lionlike men of Moab: also he went down and slew a lion in a pit in a snowy day.

Benaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_11\_24</u># These [things] did Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and had the name among the three mighties.

Benaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_18\_17</u># And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and the sons of David [were] chief about the king.

Benaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_27\_05</u># The third captain of the host for the third month [was] Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, a chief priest: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

Benaiah <u>15\_EZR\_10\_25</u> # Moreover of Israel: of the sons of Parosh; Ramiah, and Jeziah, and Malchiah, and Miamin, and Eleazar, and Malchijah, and Benaiah.

Benaiah <u>15\_EZR\_10\_43</u> # Of the sons of Nebo; Jeiel, Mattithiah, Zabad, Zebina, Jadau, and Joel, Benaiah.

Beraiah and Shimrath <u>13\_1CH\_08\_21</u> # And Adaiah, and Beraiah, and Shimrath, the sons of Shimhi;

Dalaiah and Anani 13\_1CH\_03\_24 # And the sons of Elioenai [were], Hodaiah, and Eliashib, and Pelaiah,

and Akkub, and Johanan, and Dalaiah, and Anani, seven.

Delaiah and Gemariah <u>24\_JER\_36\_25</u> # Nevertheless Elnathan and Delaiah and Gemariah had made intercession to the king that he would not burn the roll: but he would not hear them.

Delaiah the children <u>15\_EZR\_02\_60</u># The children of Delaiah, the children of Tobiah, the children of Nekoda, six hundred fifty and two.

Hodaiah and Eliashib <u>13\_1CH\_03\_24</u> # And the sons of Elioenai [were], Hodaiah, and Eliashib, and Pelaiah, and Akkub, and Johanan, and Dalaiah, and Anani, seven.

Hoshaiah and all <u>24\_JER\_42\_01</u> # Then all the captains of the forces, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and Jezaniah the son of Hoshaiah, and all the people from the least even unto the greatest, came near,

Hoshaiah and half <u>16\_NEH\_12\_32</u> # And after them went Hoshaiah, and half of the princes of Judah,

Hoshaiah and Johanan 24\_JER\_43\_02 # Then spake Azariah the son of Hoshaiah, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the proud men, saying unto Jeremiah, Thou speakest falsely: the LORD our God hath not sent thee to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there:

Isaiah had said <u>23\_ISA\_38\_21</u># For Isaiah had said, Let them take a lump of figs, and lay [it] for a plaster upon the boil, and he shall recover.

Ismaiah the Gibeonite <u>13\_1CH\_12\_04</u> # And Ismaiah the Gibeonite, a mighty man among the thirty, and over the thirty; and Jeremiah, and Jahaziel, and Johanan, and Josabad the Gederathite,

Jedaiah and Jehoiarib <u>13\_1CH\_09\_10</u> # And of the priests; Jedaiah, and Jehoiarib, and Jachin,

Jedaiah and to <u>38\_ZEC\_06\_14</u> # And the crowns shall be to Helem, and to Tobijah, and to Jedaiah, and to Hen the son of Zephaniah, for a memorial in the temple of the LORD.

Jedaiah Nethaneel <u>16\_NEH\_12\_21</u> # Of Hilkiah, Hashabiah; of Jedaiah, Nethaneel.

Jedaiah of the <u>15\_EZR\_02\_36</u># The priests: the children of Jedaiah, of the house of Jeshua, nine hundred seventy and three.

Shemaiah the Nehelamite 24\_JER\_29\_32 # Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will punish Shemaiah the Nehelamite, and his seed: he shall not have a man to dwell among this people; neither shall he behold the good that I will do for my people, saith the LORD; because he hath taught rebellion against the LORD.

Shemaiah the prophet <u>14\_2CH\_12\_05</u># Then came Shemaiah the prophet to Rehoboam, and [to] the princes of Judah, that were gathered together to Jerusalem because of Shishak, and said unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Ye have forsaken me, and therefore have I also left you in the hand of Shishak.

Shemaiah the prophet <u>14\_2CH\_12\_15</u> # Now the acts of Rehoboam, first and last, [are] they not written in the book of Shemaiah the prophet, and of Iddo the seer concerning genealogies? And [there were] wars between Rehoboam and Jeroboam continually.

Shemaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_14</u> # And of the Levites; Shemaiah the son of Hasshub, the son of Azrikam, the son of Hashabiah, of the sons of Merari;

Shemaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_09\_16</u> # And Obadiah the son of Shemaiah, the son of Galal, the son of

Jeduthun, and Berechiah the son of Asa, the son of Elkanah, that dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.

Shemaiah the son <u>13\_1CH\_24\_06</u> # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

Shemaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_03\_29</u># After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the east gate.

Shemaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_06\_10</u> # Afterward I came unto the house of Shemaiah the son of Delaiah the son of Mehetabeel, who [was] shut up; and he said, Let us meet together in the house of God, within the temple, and let us shut the doors of the temple: for they will come to slay thee; yea, in the night will they come to slay thee.

Shemaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_15</u># Also of the Levites: Shemaiah the son of Hashub, the son of Azrikam, the son of Bunni;

Shemaiah the son <u>16\_NEH\_12\_35</u># And [certain] of the priests' sons with trumpets; [namely], Zechariah the son of Jonathan, the son of Shemaiah, the son of Mattaniah, the son of Michaiah, the son of Zaccur, the son of Asaph:

Shemaiah these were <u>16\_NEH\_10\_08</u># Maaziah, Bilgai, Shemaiah: these [were] the priests.

Shemaiah <u>13\_1CH\_04\_37</u> # And Ziza the son of Shiphi, the son of Allon, the son of Jedaiah, the son of Shimri, the son of Shemaiah;
