

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Aliah duke Jetheth <u>13\_1CH\_01\_51</u># Hadad died also. And the dukes of Edom were; duke Timnah, duke Aliah, duke Jetheth,

Athaliah and with <u>15\_EZR\_08\_07</u># And of the sons of Elam; Jeshaiah the son of Athaliah, and with him seventy males.

Athaliah did reign <u>12\_2KI\_11\_03</u># And he was with her hid in the house of the LORD six years. And Athaliah did reign over the land.

Athaliah heard the <u>14\_2CH\_23\_12</u> # Now when Athaliah heard the noise of the people running and praising the king, she came to the people into the house of the LORD:

Athaliah heard the <u>12\_2KI\_11\_13</u># And when Athaliah heard the noise of the guard [and] of the people, she came to the people into the temple of the LORD.

Athaliah reigned over <u>14\_2CH\_22\_12</u> # And he was with them hid in the house of God six years: and Athaliah reigned over the land.

Athaliah rent her <u>14\_2CH\_23\_13</u> # And she looked, and, behold, the king stood at his pillar at the entering in, and the princes and the trumpets by the king: and all the people of the land rejoiced, and sounded with trumpets, also the singers with instruments of music, and such as taught to sing praise. Then Athaliah rent her clothes, and said, Treason, Treason.

Athaliah rent her <u>12\_2KI\_11\_14</u># And when she looked, behold, the king stood by a pillar, as the manner [was], and the princes and the trumpeters by the king, and all the people of the land rejoiced, and blew with trumpets: and Athaliah rent her clothes, and cried, Treason, Treason.

Athaliah so that <u>14\_2CH\_22\_11</u> # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Athaliah so that <u>12\_2KI\_11\_02</u># But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Athaliah that wicked <u>14\_2CH\_24\_07</u> # For the sons of Athaliah, that wicked woman, had broken up the house of God; and also all the dedicated things of the house of the LORD did they bestow upon Baalim.

Athaliah the daughter <u>14\_2CH\_22\_02</u> # Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

Athaliah the daughter <u>12\_2KI\_08\_26</u># Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Athaliah the mother <u>14\_2CH\_22\_10</u> # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Athaliah the mother <u>12\_2KI\_11\_01</u># And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

Athaliah with the <u>14\_2CH\_23\_21</u># And all the people of the land rejoiced: and the city was quiet, after that they had slain Athaliah with the sword.

Athaliah with the <u>12\_2KI\_11\_20</u># And all the people of the land rejoiced, and the city was in quiet: and they slew Athaliah with the sword [beside] the king's house.

Athaliah <u>13\_1CH\_08\_26</u> # And Shamsherai, and Shehariah, and Athaliah,

Azaliah and Maaseiah <u>14\_2CH\_34\_08</u> # Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had purged the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of the LORD his God.

Azaliah the son <u>12\_2KI\_22\_03</u> # And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [that] the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying,

Bealiah and Shemariah <u>13\_1CH\_12\_05</u># Eluzai, and Jerimoth, and Bealiah, and Shemariah, and Shephatiah the Haruphite,

Gedaliah and no <u>24\_JER\_41\_04</u># And it came to pass the second day after he had slain Gedaliah, and no man knew [it],

Gedaliah and Zeri <u>13\_1CH\_25\_03</u> # Of Jeduthun: the sons of Jeduthun; Gedaliah, and Zeri, and Jeshaiah, Hashabiah, and Mattithiah, six, under the hands of their father Jeduthun, who prophesied with a harp, to give thanks and to praise the LORD.

Gedaliah at Mizpah <u>24\_JER\_41\_03</u> # Ishmael also slew all the Jews that were with him, [even] with Gedaliah, at Mizpah, and the Chaldeans that were found there, [and] the men of war.

Gedaliah governor there <u>12\_2KI\_25\_23</u> # And when all the captains of the armies, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah governor, there came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan the son of Careah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite, and Jaazaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Gedaliah in Mizpah <u>24\_JER\_40\_15</u> # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

Gedaliah sware to <u>12\_2KI\_25\_24</u># And Gedaliah sware to them, and to their men, and said unto them, Fear not to be the servants of the Chaldees: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon; and it shall be well with you.

Gedaliah that he <u>12\_2KI\_25\_25</u> # But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and smote Gedaliah, that he died, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah.

Gedaliah the son <u>12\_2KI\_25\_22</u># And [as for] the people that remained in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon had left, even over them he made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, the son of Shaphan, ruler.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_38\_01 # Then Shephatiah the son of Mattan, and Gedaliah the son of Pashur,

and Jucal the son of Shelemiah, and Pashur the son of Malchiah, heard the words that Jeremiah had spoken unto all the people, saying,

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_39\_14 # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he dwelt among the people.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_40\_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

Gedaliah the son <u>24\_JER\_40\_06</u># Then went Jeremiah unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and dwelt with him among the people that were left in the land.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_40\_07 # Now when all the captains of the forces which [were] in the fields, [even] they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah the son of Ahikam governor in the land, and had committed unto him men, and women, and children, and of the poor of the land, of them that were not carried away captive to Babylon;

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_40\_09 # And Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan sware unto them and to their men, saying, Fear not to serve the Chaldeans: dwell in the land, and serve the king of Babylon, and it shall be well with you.

Gedaliah the son <u>24\_JER\_40\_11</u># Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_40\_14 # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_40\_16 # But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam said unto Johanan the son of Kareah, Thou shalt not do this thing: for thou speakest falsely of Ishmael.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_41\_01 # Now it came to pass in the seventh month, [that] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, and the princes of the king, even ten men with him, came unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and there they did eat bread together in Mizpah.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_41\_02 # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_41\_06 # And Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went forth from Mizpah to meet them, weeping all along as he went: and it came to pass, as he met them, he said unto them, Come to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_41\_10 # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_41\_16 # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war,

and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Gedaliah the son <u>24\_JER\_41\_18</u># Because of the Chaldeans: for they were afraid of them, because Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon made governor in the land.

Gedaliah the son 24\_JER\_43\_06 # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Gedaliah the son <u>36\_ZEP\_01\_01</u># The word of the LORD which came unto Zephaniah the son of Cushi, the son of Gedaliah, the son of Amariah, the son of Hizkiah, in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah.

Gedaliah to Mizpah <u>12\_2KI\_25\_23</u> # And when all the captains of the armies, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah governor, there came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan the son of Careah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite, and Jaazaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Gedaliah to Mizpah <u>24\_JER\_40\_08</u> # Then they came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan and Jonathan the sons of Kareah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth, and the sons of Ephai the Netophathite, and Jezaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Gedaliah to Mizpah <u>24\_JER\_40\_13</u> # Moreover Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] in the fields, came to Gedaliah to Mizpah,

Gedaliah unto Mizpah 24\_JER\_40\_12 # Even all the Jews returned out of all places whither they were driven, and came to the land of Judah, to Gedaliah, unto Mizpah, and gathered wine and summer fruits very much.

Gedaliah was it 24\_JER\_41\_09 # Now the pit wherein Ishmael had cast all the dead bodies of the men, whom he had slain because of Gedaliah, [was] it which Asa the king had made for fear of Baasha king of Israel: [and] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled it with [them that were] slain.

Gedaliah who with <u>13\_1CH\_25\_09</u> # Now the first lot came forth for Asaph to Joseph: the second to Gedaliah, who with his brethren and sons [were] twelve:

Gedaliah <u>15\_EZR\_10\_18</u># And among the sons of the priests there were found that had taken strange wives: [namely], of the sons of Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren; Maaseiah, and Eliezer, and Jarib, and Gedaliah.

Hachaliah And it <u>16\_NEH\_01\_01</u> # The words of Nehemiah the son of Hachaliah. And it came to pass in the month Chisleu, in the twentieth year, as I was in Shushan the palace,

Hachaliah and Zidkijah <u>16\_NEH\_10\_01</u> # Now those that sealed [were], Nehemiah, the Tirshatha, the son of Hachaliah, and Zidkijah,

Igdaliah a man 24\_JER\_35\_04 # And I brought them into the house of the LORD, into the chamber of the sons of Hanan, the son of Igdaliah, a man of God, which [was] by the chamber of the princes, which [was] above the chamber of Maaseiah the son of Shallum, the keeper of the door:

Pelaliah the son <u>16\_NEH\_11\_12</u># And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

Remaliah a captain <u>12\_2KI\_15\_25</u> # But Pekah the son of Remaliah, a captain of his, conspired against him, and smote him in Samaria, in the palace of the king's house, with Argob and Arieh, and with him fifty men of the Gileadites: and he killed him, and reigned in his room.

Remaliah Ahaz the <u>12\_2KI\_16\_01</u> # In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.

Remaliah and smote <u>12\_2KI\_15\_30</u> # And Hoshea the son of Elah made a conspiracy against Pekah the son of Remaliah, and smote him, and slew him, and reigned in his stead, in the twentieth year of Jotham the son of Uzziah.

Remaliah began to <u>12\_2KI\_15\_27</u> # In the two and fiftieth year of Azariah king of Judah Pekah the son of Remaliah began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] twenty years.

Remaliah have taken <u>23\_ISA\_07\_05</u># Because Syria, Ephraim, and the son of Remaliah, have taken evil counsel against thee, saying,

Remaliah king of <u>12\_2KI\_15\_32</u># In the second year of Pekah the son of Remaliah king of Israel began Jotham the son of Uzziah king of Judah to reign.

Remaliah king of <u>12\_2KI\_16\_05</u># Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

Remaliah king of 23\_ISA\_07\_01 # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Remaliah slew in <u>14\_2CH\_28\_06</u># For Pekah the son of Remaliah slew in Judah an hundred and twenty thousand in one day, [which were] all valiant men; because they had forsaken the LORD God of their fathers.

Remaliah <u>12\_2KI\_15\_37</u># In those days the LORD began to send against Judah Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah.

Remaliah <u>23\_ISA\_07\_04</u> # And say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; fear not, neither be fainthearted for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah.

Remaliah's son If <u>23\_ISA\_07\_09</u> # And the head of Ephraim [is] Samaria, and the head of Samaria [is] Remaliah's son. If ye will not believe, surely ye shall not be established.

Remaliah's son <u>23\_ISA\_08\_06</u># Forasmuch as this people refuseth the waters of Shiloah that go softly, and rejoice in Rezin and Remaliah's son;

Tebaliah the third <u>13\_1CH\_26\_11</u># Hilkiah the second, Tebaliah the third, Zechariah the fourth: all the sons and brethren of Hosah [were] thirteen.
