

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Amaziah and he <u>14\_2CH\_25\_15</u># Wherefore the anger of the LORD was kindled against Amaziah, and he sent unto him a prophet, which said unto him, Why hast thou sought after the gods of the people, which could not deliver their own people out of thine hand?

Amaziah are they 12\_2KI\_14\_18 # And the rest of the acts of Amaziah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Amaziah did turn <u>14\_2CH\_25\_27</u> # Now after the time that Amaziah did turn away from following the LORD they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem; and he fled to Lachish: but they sent to Lachish after him, and slew him there.

Amaziah did 14\_2CH\_26\_04 # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah did.

Amaziah first and 14\_2CH\_25\_26 # Now the rest of the acts of Amaziah, first and last, behold, [are] they not written in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel?

Amaziah gathered Judah <u>14\_2CH\_25\_05</u># Moreover Amaziah gathered Judah together, and made them captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, according to the houses of [their] fathers, throughout all Judah and Benjamin: and he numbered them from twenty years old and above, and found them three hundred thousand choice [men, able] to go forth to war, that could handle spear and shield.

Amaziah had done 12\_2KI\_15\_03 # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah had done;

Amaziah his son 13\_1CH\_03\_12 # Amaziah his son, Azariah his son, Jotham his son,

Amaziah his son <u>14\_2CH\_24\_27</u> # Now [concerning] his sons, and the greatness of the burdens [laid] upon him, and the repairing of the house of God, behold, they [are] written in the story of the book of the kings. And Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Amaziah his son 12\_2KI\_12\_21# For Jozachar the son of Shimeath, and Jehozabad the son of Shomer, his servants, smote him, and he died; and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: and Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Amaziah I was 30\_AMO\_07\_14 # Then answered Amos, and said to Amaziah, I [was] no prophet, neither [was] I a prophet's son; but I [was] an herdman, and a gatherer of sycamore fruit:

Amaziah king of 14\_2CH\_25\_17 # Then Amaziah king of Judah took advice, and sent to Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, the son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us see one another in the face.

Amaziah king of 14\_2CH\_25\_18 # And Joash king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, The thistle that [was] in Lebanon sent to the cedar that [was] in Lebanon, saying, Give thy daughter to my son to wife: and there passed by a wild beast that [was] in Lebanon, and trode down the thistle.

Amaziah king of 14\_2CH\_25\_21 # So Joash the king of Israel went up; and they saw one another in the face, [both] he and Amaziah king of Judah, at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Amaziah king of 14\_2CH\_25\_23 # And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Amaziah king of 12\_2KI\_13\_12# And the rest of the acts of Joash, and all that he did, and his might wherewith he fought against Amaziah king of Judah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Amaziah king of 12\_2KI\_14\_09 # And Jehoash the king of Israel sent to Amaziah king of Judah, saying, The thistle that [was] in Lebanon sent to the cedar that [was] in Lebanon, saying, Give thy daughter to my son to wife: and there passed by a wild beast that [was] in Lebanon, and trode down the thistle.

Amaziah king of <u>12\_2KI\_14\_11</u># But Amaziah would not hear. Therefore Jehoash king of Israel went up; and he and Amaziah king of Judah looked one another in the face at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Amaziah king of 12\_2KI\_14\_13# And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Amaziah king of 12\_2KI\_14\_15# Now the rest of the acts of Jehoash which he did, and his might, and how he fought with Amaziah king of Judah, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Amaziah king of 12 2KI 15 01 # In the twenty and seventh year of Jeroboam king of Israel began Azariah son of Amaziah king of Judah to reign.

Amaziah said to 14\_2CH\_25\_09 # And Amaziah said to the man of God, But what shall we do for the hundred talents which I have given to the army of Israel? And the man of God answered, The LORD is able to give thee much more than this.

Amaziah said unto 30\_AMO\_07\_12 # Also Amaziah said unto Amos, O thou seer, go, flee thee away into the land of Judah, and there eat bread, and prophesy there:

Amaziah sent back <u>14\_2CH\_25\_13</u> # But the soldiers of the army which Amaziah sent back, that they should not go with him to battle, fell upon the cities of Judah, from Samaria even unto Bethhoron, and smote three thousand of them, and took much spoil.

Amaziah sent messengers <u>12\_2KI\_14\_08</u># Then Amaziah sent messengers to Jehoash, the son of Jehoahaz son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us look one another in the face.

Amaziah separated them <u>14\_2CH\_25\_10</u> # Then Amaziah separated them, [to wit], the army that was come to him out of Ephraim, to go home again: wherefore their anger was greatly kindled against Judah, and they returned home in great anger.

Amaziah strengthened himself <u>14\_2CH\_25\_11</u># And Amaziah strengthened himself, and led forth his people, and went to the valley of salt, and smote of the children of Seir ten thousand.

Amaziah the priest <u>30\_AMO\_07\_10</u> # Then Amaziah the priest of Bethel sent to Jeroboam king of Israel, saying, Amos hath conspired against thee in the midst of the house of Israel: the land is not able to bear all his words.

Amaziah the son 13\_1CH\_06\_45 # The son of Hashabiah, the son of Amaziah, the son of Hilkiah,

Amaziah the son 14\_2CH\_25\_25 # And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of

Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Amaziah the son 12\_2KI\_14\_01 # In the second year of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel reigned Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah.

Amaziah the son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_17</u> # And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Amaziah the son <u>12\_2KI\_14\_23</u> # In the fifteenth year of Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah Jeroboam the son of Joash king of Israel began to reign in Samaria, [and reigned] forty and one years.

Amaziah was come <u>14\_2CH\_25\_14</u> # Now it came to pass, after that Amaziah was come from the slaughter of the Edomites, that he brought the gods of the children of Seir, and set them up [to be] his gods, and bowed down himself before them, and burned incense unto them.

Amaziah was twenty 14\_2CH\_25\_01 # Amaziah [was] twenty and five years old [when] he began to reign, and he reigned twenty and nine years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jehoaddan of Jerusalem.

Amaziah would not 14\_2CH\_25\_20 # But Amaziah would not hear; for it [came] of God, that he might deliver them into the hand [of their enemies], because they sought after the gods of Edom.

Amaziah would not 12\_2KI\_14\_11# But Amaziah would not hear. Therefore Jehoash king of Israel went up; and he and Amaziah king of Judah looked one another in the face at Bethshemesh, which [belongeth] to Judah.

Amaziah 13\_1CH\_04\_34 # And Meshobab, and Jamlech, and Joshah, the son of Amaziah,

Amaziah <u>14\_2CH\_26\_01</u># Then all the people of Judah took Uzziah, who [was] sixteen years old, and made him king in the room of his father Amaziah.

Amaziah 12 2KI 14 21 # And all the people of Judah took Azariah, which [was] sixteen years old, and made him king instead of his father Amaziah.
