Ammon and against <u>09_1SA_14_47</u> # So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

Ammon and Amalek <u>07_JUD_03_13</u># And he gathered unto him the children of Ammon and Amalek, and went and smote Israel, and possessed the city of palm trees.

Ammon and Amalek <u>19_PSA_83_07</u> # Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre;

Ammon and be <u>07_JUD_11_08</u># And the elders of Gilead said unto Jephthah, Therefore we turn again to thee now, that thou mayest go with us, and fight against the children of Ammon, and be our head over all the inhabitants of Gilead.

Ammon and besieged <u>10_2SA_11_01</u># And it came to pass, after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth [to battle], that David sent Joab, and his servants with him, and all Israel; and they destroyed the children of Ammon, and besieged Rabbah. But David tarried still at Jerusalem.

Ammon and came <u>13_1CH_20_01</u># And it came to pass, that after the year was expired, at the time that kings go out [to battle], Joab led forth the power of the army, and wasted the country of the children of Ammon, and came and besieged Rabbah. Ammon and from 13_1CH_18_11# Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all [these] nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.

Ammon and from <u>07_JUD_10_11</u># And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, [Did] not [I deliver you] from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

Ammon and have 11_1KI_11_33# Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon,

and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

Ammon and Machir <u>10_2SA_17_27</u># And it came to pass, when David was come to Mahanaim, that Shobi the son of Nahash of Rabbah of the children of Ammon, and Machir the son of Ammiel of Lodebar, and Barzillai the Gileadite of Rogelim,

Ammon and Moab <u>14_2CH_20_10</u> # And now, behold, the children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir, whom thou wouldest not let Israel invade, when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them, and destroyed them not;

Ammon and Moab <u>14_2CH_20_23</u> # For the children of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy [them]: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to destroy another.

Ammon and Moab <u>24_JER_09_26</u># Egypt, and Judah, and Edom, and the children of Ammon, and Moab, and all [that are] in the utmost corners, that dwell in the wilderness: for all [these] nations [are] uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel [are] uncircumcised in the heart.

Ammon and of <u>10_2SA_08_12</u># Of Syria, and of Moab, and of the children of Ammon, and of the Philistines, and of Amalek, and of the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.

Ammon and of <u>16_NEH_13_23</u># In those days also saw I Jews [that] had married wives of Ashdod, of Ammon, [and] of Moab:

Ammon and took 10_28A_12_26 # And Joab fought against Rabbah of the children of Ammon, and took the royal city.

Ammon and when <u>07_JUD_12_02</u># And Jephthah said unto them, I and my people were at great strife with the children of Ammon; and when I called you, ye delivered me not out of their hands.

Ammon and with 14_2CH_20_01 # It came to pass after this also, [that] the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them [other] beside the Ammonites, came against Jehoshaphat to battle.

Ammon answered unto <u>07_JUD_11_13</u># And the king of the children of Ammon answered unto the messengers of Jephthah, Because Israel took away my land, when they came up out of Egypt, from Arnon even unto Jabbok, and unto Jordan: now therefore restore those [lands] again peaceably.

Ammon any more 13_1CH_19_19 # And when the servants of Hadarezer saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they made peace with David, and became his servants: neither would the Syrians help

the children of Ammon any more.

Ammon any more 10 2SA 10 19 # And when all the kings [that were] servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made peace with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more.

Ammon any possession <u>05_DEU_02_19</u> # And [when] thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon [any] possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

Ammon as Gomorrah <u>36 ZEP_02_09</u># Therefore [as] I live, saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Surely Moab shall be as Sodom, and the children of Ammon as Gomorrah, [even] the breeding of nettles, and saltpits, and a perpetual desolation: the residue of my people shall spoil them, and the remnant of my people shall possess them.

Ammon be too 13_1CH_19_12 # And he said, If the Syrians be too strong for me, then thou shalt help me: but if the children of Ammon be too strong for thee, then I will help thee.

Ammon be too <u>10_2SA_10_11</u># And he said, If the Syrians be too strong for me, then thou shalt help me: but if the children of Ammon be too strong for thee, then I will come and help thee.

Ammon came against <u>09_1SA_12_12</u># And when ye saw that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon came against you, ye said unto me, Nay; but a king shall reign over us: when the LORD your God [was] your king.

Ammon came out <u>13_1CH_19_09</u># And the children of Ammon came out, and put the battle in array before the gate of the city: and the kings that were come [were] by themselves in the field.

Ammon came out <u>10_2SA_10_08</u># And the children of Ammon came out, and put the battle in array at the entering in of the gate: and the Syrians of Zoba, and of Rehob, and Ishtob, and Maacah, [were] by themselves in the field.

Ammon did the 12_2KI_23_13# And the high places that [were] before Jerusalem, which [were] on the right hand of the mount of corruption, which Solomon the king of Israel had builded for Ashtoreth the abomination of the Zidonians, and for Chemosh the abomination of the Moabites, and for Milcom the abomination of the children of Ammon, did the king defile.

Ammon died and <u>13_1CH_19_01</u> # Now it came to pass after this, that Nahash the king of the children of Ammon died, and his son reigned in his stead.

Ammon died and 10_28A_10_01 # And it came to pass after this, that the king of the children of Ammon died, and Hanun his son reigned in his stead.

Ammon distress them <u>05_DEU_02_19</u> # And [when] thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon [any] possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

Ammon for the <u>04_NUM_21_24</u># And Israel smote him with the edge of the sword, and possessed his land from Arnon unto Jabbok, even unto the children of Ammon: for the border of the children of Ammon [was] strong.

Ammon gathered themselves <u>13_1CH_19_07</u> # So they hired thirty and two thousand chariots, and the king of Maachah and his people; who came and pitched before Medeba. And the children of Ammon gathered themselves together from their cities, and came to battle.

Ammon gave him <u>14_2CH_27_05</u># He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. Ammon hearkened not <u>07_JUD_11_28</u># Howbeit the king of the children of Ammon hearkened not unto the words of Jephthah which he sent him.

Ammon into mine <u>07_JUD_11_30</u># And Jephthah vowed a vow unto the LORD, and said, If thou shalt without fail deliver the children of Ammon into mine hands,

Ammon made war <u>07_JUD_11_04</u># And it came to pass in process of time, that the children of Ammon made war against Israel.

Ammon made war <u>07_JUD_11_05</u># And it was so, that when the children of Ammon made war against Israel, the elders of Gilead went to fetch Jephthah out of the land of Tob:

Ammon Moab and <u>14_2CH_20_22</u># And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

Ammon nine cubits <u>05_DEU_03_11</u># For only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of giants; behold, his bedstead [was] a bedstead of iron; [is] it not in Rabbath of the children of Ammon? nine cubits [was] the length thereof, and four cubits the breadth of it, after the cubit of a man.

Ammon passed over <u>07_JUD_10_09</u> # Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight also against Judah, and against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim; so that Israel was sore distressed.

Ammon pay unto 14_2CH_27_05# He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

Ammon said to 13 1CH 19 03 # But the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? are not his servants come unto thee for to search, and to overthrow, and to spy out the land?

Ammon said unto 10_2SA_10_03 # And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

Ammon saith the <u>24_JER_49_06</u># And afterward I will bring again the captivity of the children of Ammon, saith the LORD.

Ammon saw that <u>13_1CH_19_06</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.

Ammon saw that <u>13_1CH_19_15</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, they likewise fled before Abishai his brother, and entered into the city. Then Joab came to Jerusalem.

Ammon saw that <u>10_2SA_10_06</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that they stank before David, the children of Ammon sent and hired the Syrians of Bethrehob, and the Syrians of Zoba, twenty thousand footmen, and of king Maacah a thousand men, and of Ishtob twelve thousand men.

Ammon saw that <u>10_2SA_10_14</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that the Syrians were fled, then fled they also before Abishai, and entered into the city. So Joab returned from the children of Ammon, and came to Jerusalem.

Ammon saying What <u>07_JUD_11_12</u># And Jephthah sent messengers unto the king of the children of Ammon, saying, What hast thou to do with me, that thou art come against me to fight in my land?

Ammon sent a <u>13_1CH_19_06</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.

Ammon sent and <u>10_2SA_10_06</u># And when the children of Ammon saw that they stank before David, the children of Ammon sent and hired the Syrians of Bethrehob, and the Syrians of Zoba, twenty thousand footmen, and of king Maacah a thousand men, and of Ishtob twelve thousand men.

Ammon shall obey <u>23_ISA_11_14</u># But they shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall obey them.

Ammon shall surely <u>07_JUD_11_31</u># Then it shall be, that whatsoever cometh forth of the doors of my house to meet me, when I return in peace from the children of Ammon, shall surely be the LORD'S, and I will offer it up for a burnt offering.

Ammon So David 10_2SA_12_31 # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

Ammon thou camest <u>05_DEU_02_37</u># Only unto the land of the children of Ammon thou camest not, [nor] unto any place of the river Jabbok, nor unto the cities in the mountains, nor unto whatsoever the LORD our God forbad us.

Ammon to fight <u>07_JUD_11_32</u># So Jephthah passed over unto the children of Ammon to fight against them; and the LORD delivered them into his hands.

Ammon to Hanun 13_1CH_19_02 # And David said, I will show kindness unto Hanun the son of Nahash, because his father showed kindness to me. And David sent messengers to comfort him concerning his father. So the servants of David came into the land of the children of Ammon to Hanun, to comfort him.

Ammon unto Aroer <u>06_JOS_13_25</u># And their coast was Jazer, and all the cities of Gilead, and half the land of the children of Ammon, unto Aroer that [is] before Rabbah;

Ammon unto this <u>01_GEN_19_38</u> # And the younger, she also bare a son, and called his name Benammi: the same [is] the father of the children of Ammon unto this day.

Ammon was strong <u>04_NUM_21_24</u> # And Israel smote him with the edge of the sword, and possessed his land from Arnon unto Jabbok, even unto the children of Ammon: for the border of the children of Ammon [was] strong.

Ammon were gathered <u>07_JUD_10_17</u> # Then the children of Ammon were gathered together, and encamped in Gilead. And the children of Israel assembled themselves together, and encamped in Mizpeh.

Ammon were subdued <u>07_JUD_11_33</u># And he smote them from Aroer, even till thou come to Minnith, [even] twenty cities, and unto the plain of the vineyards, with a very great slaughter. Thus the children of Ammon were subdued before the children of Israel.

Ammon whereby they <u>36_ZEP_02_08</u># I have heard the reproach of Moab, and the revilings of the children of Ammon, whereby they have reproached my people, and magnified [themselves] against their border.

Ammon <u>13_1CH_19_11</u> # And the rest of the people he delivered unto the hand of Abishai his brother, and they set [themselves] in array against the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>11_1KI_11_07</u># Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that [is] before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>10_2SA_10_02</u> # Then said David, I will show kindness unto Hanun the son of Nahash, as his father showed kindness unto me. And David sent to comfort him by the hand of his servants for his father. And David's servants came into the land of the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>10_2SA_10_10</u># And the rest of the people he delivered into the hand of Abishai his brother, that he might put [them] in array against the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>10_2SA_12_09</u> # Wherefore hast thou despised the commandment of the LORD, to do evil in his sight? thou hast killed Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and hast taken his wife [to be] thy wife, and hast slain him with the sword of the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>27_DAN_11_41</u># He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many [countries] shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, [even] Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>05 DEU 03 16 #</u> And unto the Reubenites and unto the Gadites I gave from Gilead even unto the river Arnon half the valley, and the border even unto the river Jabbok, [which is] the border of the children of Ammon;

Ammon 24_JER_25_21 # Edom, and Moab, and the children of Ammon,

Ammon <u>06_JOS_12_02</u># Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt in Heshbon, [and] ruled from Aroer, which [is] upon the bank of the river Arnon, and from the middle of the river, and from half Gilead, even unto the river Jabbok, [which is] the border of the children of Ammon;

Ammon <u>06_JOS_13_10</u> # And all the cities of Sihon king of the Amorites, which reigned in Heshbon, unto the border of the children of Ammon;

Ammon <u>07_JUD_10_07</u> # And the anger of the LORD was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hands of the Philistines, and into the hands of the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>07_JUD_11_06</u># And they said unto Jephthah, Come, and be our captain, that we may fight with the children of Ammon.

Ammon 07_JUD_11_14# And Jephthah sent messengers again unto the king of the children of Ammon:

Ammon <u>07_JUD_11_15</u># And said unto him, Thus saith Jephthah, Israel took not away the land of Moab, nor the land of the children of Ammon:

Ammon 07_JUD_11_27 # Wherefore I have not sinned against thee, but thou doest me wrong to war

against me: the LORD the Judge be judge this day between the children of Israel and the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>07_JUD_11_29</u># Then the spirit of the LORD came upon Jephthah, and he passed over Gilead, and Manasseh, and passed over Mizpeh of Gilead, and from Mizpeh of Gilead he passed over [unto] the children of Ammon.

Ammon <u>07_JUD_11_36</u># And she said unto him, My father, [if] thou hast opened thy mouth unto the LORD, do to me according to that which hath proceeded out of thy mouth; forasmuch as the LORD hath taken vengeance for thee of thine enemies, [even] of the children of Ammon.

Ammonite and Geshem <u>16_NEH_02_19</u> # But when Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian, heard [it], they laughed us to scorn, and despised us, and said, What [is] this thing that ye do? will ye rebel against the king?

Ammonite and the <u>16_NEH_13_01</u># On that day they read in the book of Moses in the audience of the people; and therein was found written, that the Ammonite and the Moabite should not come into the congregation of God for ever;

Ammonite answered them <u>09_1SA_11_02</u># And Nahash the Ammonite answered them, On this [condition] will I make [a covenant] with you, that I may thrust out all your right eyes, and lay it [for] a reproach upon all Israel.

Ammonite came up <u>09_1SA_11_01</u># Then Nahash the Ammonite came up, and encamped against Jabeshgilead: and all the men of Jabesh said unto Nahash, Make a covenant with us, and we will serve thee.

Ammonite heard of <u>16_NEH_02_10</u># When Sanballat the Horonite, and Tobiah the servant, the Ammonite, heard [of it], it grieved them exceedingly that there was come a man to seek the welfare of the children of Israel.

Ammonite Naharai the 13_1CH_11_39 # Zelek the Ammonite, Naharai the Berothite, the armourbearer of Joab the son of Zeruiah,

Ammonite Nahari the <u>10_2SA_23_37</u> # Zelek the Ammonite, Nahari the Beerothite, armourbearer to Joab the son of Zeruiah,

Ammonite or Moabite <u>05_DEU_23_03</u># An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to their tenth generation shall they not enter into the congregation of the LORD for ever:

Ammonite was by <u>16_NEH_04_03</u> # Now Tobiah the Ammonite [was] by him, and he said, Even that which they build, if a fox go up, he shall even break down their stone wall.

Ammonites a couchingplace 26_EZE_25_05 # And I will make Rabbah a stable for camels, and the Ammonites a couchingplace for flocks: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

Ammonites and concerning <u>26_EZE_21_28</u># And thou, son of man, prophesy and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning the Ammonites, and concerning their reproach; even say thou, The sword, the sword [is] drawn: for the slaughter [it is] furbished, to consume because of the glittering:

Ammonites and in <u>24_JER_40_11</u># Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Ammonites and it 24_JER_49_02 # Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will cause an alarm of war to be heard in Rabbah of the Ammonites; and it shall be a desolate heap, and her daughters

shall be burned with fire: then shall Israel be heir unto them that were his heirs, saith the LORD.

Ammonites and prevailed 14_2CH_27_05# He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

Ammonites and prophesy <u>26_EZE_25_02</u> # Son of man, set thy face against the Ammonites, and prophesy against them;

Ammonites and the <u>16_NEH_04_07</u> # But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,

Ammonites and to <u>26_EZE_21_20</u># Appoint a way, that the sword may come to Rabbath of the Ammonites, and to Judah in Jerusalem the defenced.

Ammonites and to <u>24_JER_27_03</u> # And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah;

Ammonites and will <u>26_EZE_25_10</u> # Unto the men of the east with the Ammonites, and will give them in possession, that the Ammonites may not be remembered among the nations.

Ammonites call them <u>05_DEU_02_20</u># [That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims;

Ammonites came against <u>14_2CH_20_01</u> # It came to pass after this also, [that] the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them [other] beside the Ammonites, came against Jehoshaphat to battle.

Ammonites Edomites Zidonians 11_1KI_11_01# But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Ammonites gave gifts <u>14_2CH_26_08</u> # And the Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: and his name spread abroad [even] to the entering in of Egypt; for he strengthened [himself] exceedingly.

Ammonites hath sent 24_JER_40_14 # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

Ammonites Hear the <u>26_EZE_25_03</u># And say unto the Ammonites, Hear the word of the Lord GOD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because thou saidst, Aha, against my sanctuary, when it was profaned; and against the land of Israel, when it was desolate; and against the house of Judah, when they went into captivity;

Ammonites may not <u>26_EZE_25_10</u> # Unto the men of the east with the Ammonites, and will give them in possession, that the Ammonites may not be remembered among the nations.

Ammonites the Moabites 15_EZR_09_01 # Now when these things were done, the princes came to me, saying, The people of Israel, and the priests, and the Levites, have not separated themselves from the people of the lands, [doing] according to their abominations, [even] of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Jebusites, the Ammonites, the Moabites, the Egyptians, and the Amorites.

Ammonites thus saith <u>24_JER_49_01</u># Concerning the Ammonites, thus saith the LORD; Hath Israel no sons? hath he no heir? why [then] doth their king inherit Gad, and his people dwell in his cities?

Ammonites until the <u>09_1SA_11_11</u># And it was [so] on the morrow, that Saul put the people in three companies; and they came into the midst of the host in the morning watch, and slew the Ammonites until the heat of the day: and it came to pass, that they which remained were scattered, so that two of them were not left together.

Ammonites 11_1KI_11_05# For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites.

Ammonites 24_JER_41_10 # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Ammonites <u>24_JER_41_15</u> # But Ishmael the son of Nethaniah escaped from Johanan with eight men, and went to the Ammonites.

Ammonitess And Abijam 11_1KI_14_31 # And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess. And Abijam his son reigned in his stead.

Ammonitess and Jehozabad <u>14_2CH_24_26</u> # And these are they that conspired against him; Zabad the son of Shimeath an Ammonitess, and Jehozabad the son of Shimrith a Moabitess.

Ammonitess 11_1KI_14_21 # And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Hammon with her <u>13_1CH_06_76</u> # And out of the tribe of Naphtali; Kedesh in Galilee with her suburbs, and Hammon with her suburbs, and Kirjathaim with her suburbs.

mammon of unrighteousness <u>42_LUK_16_09</u># And I say unto you, Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of unrighteousness; that, when ye fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations.

mammon who will <u>42_LUK_16_11</u> # If therefore ye have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true [riches]?

mammon <u>42_LUK_16_13</u> # No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

mammon <u>40_MAT_06_24</u># No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.
