parable against him <u>35_HAB_02_06</u># Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth [that which is] not his! how long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

parable against them <u>42_LUK_20_19</u> # And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

parable Behold the <u>42_LUK_21_29</u> # And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees;

parable I will <u>19_PSA_49_04</u># I will incline mine ear to a parable: I will open my dark saying upon the harp.

parable There was <u>40_MAT_21_33</u># Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and digged a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country:

parable to those <u>42_LUK_14_07</u> # And he put forth a parable to those which were bidden, when he marked

how they chose out the chief rooms; saying unto them,

parable unto certain <u>42_LUK_18_09</u> # And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

parables A certain <u>41_MAR_12_01</u> # And he began to speak unto them by parables. A [certain] man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about [it], and digged [a place for] the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country.

parables and said <u>41_MAR_04_02</u> # And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine,

parables and said <u>40_MAT_22_01</u># And Jesus answered and spake unto them again by parables, and said,

parables and without <u>40_MAT_13_34</u># All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake he not unto them:

parables because they <u>40_MAT_13_13</u># Therefore speak I to them in parables: because they seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they understand.

parables spake he <u>41_MAR_04_33</u> # And with many such parables spake he the word unto them, as they were able to hear [it].

parables that seeing <u>42_LUK_08_10</u>[#] And he said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God: but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not understand.

parables they perceived <u>40_MAT_21_45</u># And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them.

parables 26_EZE_20_49 # Then said I, Ah Lord GOD! they say of me, Doth he not speak parables?

parables <u>41_MAR_04_11</u># And he said unto them, Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God: but unto them that are without, all [these] things are done in parables:
