

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Arimathaea a city <u>42\_LUK\_23\_51</u># [The same had not consented to the counsel and deed of them;] [he was] of Arimathaea, a city of the Jews: who also himself waited for the kingdom of God.

Arimathaea an honourable <u>41\_MAR\_15\_43</u> # Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

Arimathaea being a <u>43\_JOH\_19\_38</u># And after this Joseph of Arimathaea, being a disciple of Jesus, but secretly for fear of the Jews, besought Pilate that he might take away the body of Jesus: and Pilate gave [him] leave. He came therefore, and took the body of Jesus.

Arimathaea named Joseph <u>40\_MAT\_27\_57</u># When the even was come, there came a rich man of Arimathaea, named Joseph, who also himself was Jesus' disciple:
