Amasa Assemble me 10\_2SA\_20\_04 # Then said the king to Amasa, Assemble me the men of Judah within three days, and be thou here present.

Amasa by the <u>10\_2SA\_20\_09</u> # And Joab said to Amasa, [Art] thou in health, my brother? And Joab took Amasa by the beard with the right hand to kiss him.

Amasa captain of 10\_2SA\_17\_25 # And Absalom made Amasa captain of the host instead of Joab: which Amasa [was] a man's son, whose name [was] Ithra an Israelite, that went in to Abigail the daughter of Nahash, sister to Zeruiah Joab's mother.

Amasa out of <u>10\_2SA\_20\_12</u> # And Amasa wallowed in blood in the midst of the highway. And when the man saw that all the people stood still, he removed Amasa out of the highway into the field, and cast a cloth upon him, when he saw that every one that came by him stood still.

Amasa the son <u>11\_1KI\_02\_05</u># Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

Amasa the son 11\_1KI\_02\_32# And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

Amasa the son <u>14\_2CH\_28\_12</u> # Then certain of the heads of the children of Ephraim, Azariah the son of Johanan, Berechiah the son of Meshillemoth, and Jehizkiah the son of Shallum, and Amasa the son of Hadlai, stood up against them that came from the war,

As a and all 11\_1KI\_15\_23# The rest of all the acts of Asa, and all his might, and all that he did, and the cities which he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? Nevertheless in the time of his old age he was diseased in his feet.

As a and all <u>14\_2CH\_15\_02</u> # And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, Hear ye me, Asa, and all Judah and Benjamin; The LORD [is] with you, while ye be with him; and if ye seek him, he will be found of you; but if ye forsake him, he will forsake you.

Asa Baasha king 14\_2CH\_16\_01# In the six and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa Baasha king of Israel came up against Judah, and built Ramah, to the intent that he might let none go out or come in to Asa king of Judah.

As a began to 11 1KI 22 41 # And Jehoshaphat the son of As a began to reign over Judah in the fourth year of Ahab king of Israel.

Asa begat Josaphat <u>40\_MAT\_01\_08</u># And Asa begat Josaphat; and Josaphat begat Joram; and Joram begat Ozias;

As a brought out 14\_2CH\_16\_02 # Then As a brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

As a built with 11 1KI 15 22 # Then king As a made a proclamation throughout all Judah; none [was] exempted: and they took away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha had builded; and king As a built with them Geba of Benjamin, and Mizpah.

As a cried unto 14\_2CH\_14\_11 # And As a cried unto the LORD his God, and said, LORD, [it is] nothing with thee to help, whether with many, or with them that have no power: help us, O LORD our God; for we rest on thee, and in thy name we go against this multitude. O LORD, thou [art] our God; let not man prevail against thee.

As a cut down 14\_2CH\_15\_16# And also [concerning] Maachah the mother of As the king, he removed her from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: and As a cut down her idol, and stamped [it], and burnt [it] at the brook Kidron.

As a did that 11\_1KI\_15\_11# And As a did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, as [did] David his father.

As a did that 14\_2CH\_14\_02# And As a did [that which was] good and right in the eyes of the LORD his God:

As a first and 14\_2CH\_16\_11 # And, behold, the acts of Asa, first and last, lo, they [are] written in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

As a had an <a href="#">14\_2CH\_14\_08</a> # And As a had an army [of men] that bare targets and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these [were] mighty men of valour.

As a he took 11\_1KI\_22\_46# And the remnant of the sodomites, which remained in the days of his father Asa, he took out of the land.

As a heard these 14\_2CH\_15\_08 # And when As a heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet,

he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

As a his son 14\_2CH\_14\_01 # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and As a his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

As ain the 14\_2CH\_16\_12 # And As ain the thirty and ninth year of his reign was diseased in his feet, until his disease [was] exceeding [great]: yet in his disease he sought not to the LORD, but to the physicians.

As a king of 11\_1KI\_16\_10# And Zimri went in and smote him, and killed him, in the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah, and reigned in his stead.

As a king of 11\_1KI\_16\_15# In the twenty and seventh year of As a king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

Asa king of <u>11\_1KI\_16\_23</u># In the thirty and first year of Asa king of Judah began Omri to reign over Israel, twelve years: six years reigned he in Tirzah.

As a king of 14\_2CH\_16\_07\_# And at that time Hanani the seer came to Asa king of Judah, and said unto him, Because thou hast relied on the king of Syria, and not relied on the LORD thy God, therefore is the host of the king of Syria escaped out of thine hand.

As a king of 14\_2CH\_21\_12 # And there came a writing to him from Elijah the prophet, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the ways of Jehoshaphat thy father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Judah,

As a slept with 11 1KI 15 24 # And As a slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoshaphat his son reigned in his stead.

As a slept with 14\_2CH\_16\_13 # And As a slept with his fathers, and died in the one and fortieth year of his reign.

As the king 14\_2CH\_15\_16# And also [concerning] Maachah the mother of As the king, he removed her from [being] queen, because she had made an idol in a grove: and As a cut down her idol, and stamped [it], and burnt [it] at the brook Kidron.

As the king 14\_2CH\_16\_06# Then As the king took all Judah; and they carried away the stones of Ramah, and the timber thereof, wherewith Baasha was building; and he built therewith Geba and Mizpah.

As the king 24\_JER\_41\_09 # Now the pit wherein Ishmael had cast all the dead bodies of the men, whom he had slain because of Gedaliah, [was] it which As the king had made for fear of Baasha king of Israel: [and] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled it with [them that were] slain.

As the son 13\_1CH\_09\_16# And Obadiah the son of Shemaiah, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun, and Berechiah the son of Asa, the son of Elkanah, that dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.

As a took all 11\_1KI\_15\_18# Then As a took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king As a sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

As a was perfect 14\_2CH\_15\_17 # But the high places were not taken away out of Israel: nevertheless the heart of As awas perfect all his days.

As a was wroth 14\_2CH\_16\_10 # Then As a was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And As a oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

As a went out <u>14\_2CH\_14\_10</u># Then As a went out against him, and they set the battle in array in the valley of Zephathah at Mareshah.

As a 14\_2CH\_15\_10 # So they gathered themselves together at Jerusalem in the third month, in the fifteenth year of the reign of Asa.

Asa <a href="#">14\_2CH\_15\_19</a> # And there was no [more] war unto the five and thirtieth year of the reign of Asa.

Asa 40\_MAT\_01\_07 # And Solomon begat Roboam; and Roboam begat Abia; and Abia begat Asa;

Asa's heart was 11\_1KI\_15\_14# But the high places were not removed: nevertheless Asa's heart was perfect with the LORD all his days.

Asahel and Asahel <u>10\_28A\_02\_18</u> # And there were three sons of Zeruiah there, Joab, and Abishai, and Asahel: and Asahel [was as] light of foot as a wild roe.

Asahel and buried 10\_2SA\_02\_32 # And they took up Asahel, and buried him in the sepulchre of his father, which [was in] Bethlehem. And Joab and his men went all night, and they came to Hebron at break of day.

Asahel And he <u>10\_2SA\_02\_20</u> # Then Abner looked behind him, and said, [Art] thou Asahel? And he answered, I [am].

Asahel and Shemiramoth <u>14\_2CH\_17\_08</u># And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Asahel at Gibeon <u>10\_2SA\_03\_30</u> # So Joab and Abishai his brother slew Abner, because he had slain their brother Asahel at Gibeon in the battle.

Asahel fell down 10\_2SA\_02\_23 # Howbeit he refused to turn aside: wherefore Abner with the hinder end of the spear smote him under the fifth [rib], that the spear came out behind him; and he fell down there, and died in the same place: and it came to pass, [that] as many as came to the place where Asahel fell down and died stood still.

Asahel his brother <u>10\_2SA\_03\_27</u> # And when Abner was returned to Hebron, Joab took him aside in the gate to speak with him quietly, and smote him there under the fifth [rib], that he died, for the blood of Asahel his brother.

Asahel pursued after 10\_2SA\_02\_19 # And Asahel pursued after Abner; and in going he turned not to the right hand nor to the left from following Abner.

Asahel the brother 13\_1CH\_11\_26# Also the valiant men of the armies [were], Asahel the brother of Joab, Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Asahel the brother <u>13\_1CH\_27\_07</u> # The fourth [captain] for the fourth month [was] Asahel the brother of Joab, and Zebadiah his son after him: and in his course [were] twenty and four thousand.

Asahel the brother 10\_28A\_23\_24 # Asahel the brother of Joab [was] one of the thirty; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

Asahel three <u>13\_1CH\_02\_16</u> # Whose sisters [were] Zeruiah, and Abigail. And the sons of Zeruiah; Abishai, and Joab, and Asahel, three.

Asahel Turn thee 10\_2SA\_02\_22 # And Abner said again to Asahel, Turn thee aside from following me: wherefore should I smite thee to the ground? how then should I hold up my face to Joab thy brother?

Asahel was as 10\_2SA\_02\_18 # And there were three sons of Zeruiah there, Joab, and Abishai, and Asahel: and Asahel [was as] light of foot as a wild roe.

Asahel would not 10\_2SA\_02\_21 # And Abner said to him, Turn thee aside to thy right hand or to thy left, and lay thee hold on one of the young men, and take thee his armour. But Asahel would not turn aside from following of him.

Asahel <u>10\_2SA\_02\_30</u># And Joab returned from following Abner: and when he had gathered all the people together, there lacked of David's servants nineteen men and Asahel.

Asahiah a servant 12\_2KI\_22\_12# And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Asahiah went unto 12 2KI 22 14 # So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

Asaiah a servant <u>14\_2CH\_34\_20</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Abdon the son of Micah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king's, saying,

Asaiah and Adiel <u>13\_1CH\_04\_36</u> # And Elioenai, and Jaakobah, and Jeshohaiah, and Asaiah, and Adiel, and Jesimiel, and Benaiah,

Asaiah and Joel <u>13\_1CH\_15\_11</u> # And David called for Zadok and Abiathar the priests, and for the Levites, for Uriel, Asaiah, and Joel, Shemaiah, and Eliel, and Amminadab,

Asaiah his son 13\_1CH\_06\_30 # Shimea his son, Haggiah his son, Asaiah his son.

Asaiah the chief <u>13\_1CH\_15\_06</u> # Of the sons of Merari; Asaiah the chief, and his brethren two hundred and twenty:

Asaiah the firstborn 13\_1CH\_09\_05 # And of the Shilonites; Asaiah the firstborn, and his sons.

Asaph an hundred 15\_EZR\_02\_41 # The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred twenty and eight.

Asaph an hundred 16\_NEH\_07\_44 # The singers: the children of Asaph, an hundred forty and eight.

Asaph and Ethan <u>13\_1CH\_15\_19</u> # So the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, [were appointed] to sound with cymbals of brass;

Asaph and Heman 14\_2CH\_35\_15# And the singers the sons of Asaph [were] in their place, according to the commandment of David, and Asaph, and Heman, and Jeduthun the king's seer; and the porters [waited] at every gate; they might not depart from their service; for their brethren the Levites prepared for them.

Asaph and his <u>13\_1CH\_16\_07</u> # Then on that day David delivered first [this psalm] to thank the LORD into the hand of Asaph and his brethren.

Asaph and his <u>13\_1CH\_16\_37</u># So he left there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required:

Asaph and of <u>13\_1CH\_25\_01</u> # Moreover David and the captains of the host separated to the service of the sons of Asaph, and of Heman, and of Jeduthun, who should prophesy with harps, with psalteries, and with cymbals: and the number of the workmen according to their service was:

Asaph came the 14\_2CH\_20\_14 # Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation;

Asaph Give ear 19\_PSA\_78\_01 # Maschil of Asaph. Give ear, O my people, [to] my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.

Asaph Give ear 19\_PSA\_80\_01 # To the chief Musician upon Shoshannimeduth, A Psalm of Asaph. Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, thou that leadest Joseph like a flock; thou that dwellest [between] the cherubims, shine forth.

Asaph God standeth 19\_PSA\_82\_01 # A Psalm of Asaph. God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods.

Asaph I cried 19\_PSA\_77\_01 # To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of Asaph. I cried unto God with my voice, [even] unto God with my voice; and he gave ear unto me.

Asaph In Judah 19 PSA 76 01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. In Judah [is] God known: his name [is] great in Israel.

Asaph Jeduthun and 13\_1CH\_25\_06 # All these [were] under the hands of their father for song [in] the house of the LORD, with cymbals, psalteries, and harps, for the service of the house of God, according to the king's order to Asaph, Jeduthun, and Heman.
