Assyria 23\_ISA\_37\_21 # Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent unto Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Whereas thou hast prayed to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria:

Assyria 24\_JER\_02\_36 # Why gaddest thou about so much to change thy way? thou also shalt be ashamed of Egypt, as thou wast ashamed of Assyria.

Assyria <u>24\_JER\_50\_18</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

Assyrian and sent <u>28\_HOS\_05\_13</u># When Ephraim saw his sickness, and Judah [saw] his wound, then went Ephraim to the Assyrian, and sent to king Jareb: yet could he not heal you, nor cure you of your wound.

Assyrian be beaten 23 ISA 30 31 # For through the voice of the LORD shall the Assyrian be beaten down, [which] smote with a rod.

Assyrian fall with <u>23\_ISA\_31\_08</u># Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

Assyrian founded it <u>23\_ISA\_23\_13</u># Behold the land of the Chaldeans; this people was not, [till] the Assyrian founded it for them that dwell in the wilderness: they set up the towers thereof, they raised up the palaces thereof; [and] he brought it to ruin.

Assyrian shall come 23 ISA 19 23 # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Assyrian shall come <u>33 MIC\_05\_05</u> # And this [man] shall be the peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

Assyrian the rod 23\_ISA\_10\_05 # O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine indignation.

Assyrian was a 26\_EZE\_31\_03 # Behold, the Assyrian [was] a cedar in Lebanon with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs.

Assyrian when he <u>33\_MIC\_05\_06</u># And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver [us] from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

Assyrians a hundred <u>23\_ISA\_37\_36</u># Then the angel of the LORD went forth, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians a hundred and fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they [were] all dead corpses.

Assyrians an hundred 12 2KI 19 35 # And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the LORD went out, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they [were] all dead corpses.

Assyrians and oil <u>28\_HOS\_12\_01</u># Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a covenant with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt.

Assyrians because thou <u>26\_EZE\_16\_28</u> # Thou hast played the whore also with the Assyrians, because thou wast unsatiable; yea, thou hast played the harlot with them, and yet couldest not be satisfied.

Assyrians her neighbours <u>26\_EZE\_23\_05</u> # And Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her lovers, on the Assyrians [her] neighbours,

Assyrians her neighbours <u>26\_EZE\_23\_12</u> # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

Assyrians to be <u>25\_LAM\_05\_06</u># We have given the hand [to] the Egyptians, [and to] the Assyrians, to be satisfied with bread.

Assyrians upon whom <u>26\_EZE\_23\_09</u> # Wherefore I have delivered her into the hand of her lovers, into the hand of the Assyrians, upon whom she doted.

Assyrians with them <u>26\_EZE\_23\_23</u># The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

Assyrians 23 ISA 19 23 # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.
