able according to <u>05\_DEU\_16\_17</u># Every man [shall give] as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD thy God which he hath given thee.

able after my <u>61\_2PE\_01\_15</u># Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance.

able also to <u>58\_HEB\_07\_25</u># Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

able also to <u>59\_JAM\_03\_02</u># For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same [is] a perfect man, [and] able also to bridle the whole body.

able men for <u>13\_1CH\_26\_08</u> # All these of the sons of Obededom: they and their sons and their brethren, able men for strength for the service, [were] threescore and two of Obededom.

able men out 02\_EXO\_18\_25 # And Moses chose able men out of all Israel, and made them heads over the

people, rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens.

able to abase <u>27\_DAN\_04\_37</u># Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works [are] truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.

able to abide 24\_JER\_10\_10# But the LORD [is] the true God, he [is] the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

able to deliver 14\_2CH\_32\_14 # Who [was there] among all the gods of those nations that my fathers utterly destroyed, that could deliver his people out of mine hand, that your God should be able to deliver you out of mine hand?

able to do <u>42\_LUK\_12\_26</u># If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?

able to do 40\_MAT\_09\_28 # And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

able to draw 43\_JOH\_21\_06 # And he said unto them, Cast the net on the right side of the ship, and ye shall find. They cast therefore, and now they were not able to draw it for the multitude of fishes.

able to go <u>04\_NUM\_01\_24</u># Of the children of Gad, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

able to go <u>04\_NUM\_01\_26</u># Of the children of Judah, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

able to go <u>04\_NUM\_01\_28</u># Of the children of Issachar, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

able to go <u>04\_NUM\_01\_30</u># Of the children of Zebulun, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

able to rise 19\_PSA\_18\_38 # I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet.

able to rise 19 PSA 36 12 # There are the workers of iniquity fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise.

able to save <u>58\_HEB\_05\_07</u># Who in the days of his flesh, when he had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto him that was able to save him from death, and was heard in that he feared;

able to save <u>59\_JAM\_01\_21</u> # Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

able to save <u>59\_JAM\_04\_12</u># There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who art thou that judgest another?

able to see <u>02\_EXO\_10\_05</u># And they shall cover the face of the earth, that one cannot be able to see the earth: and they shall eat the residue of that which is escaped, which remaineth unto you from the hail, and shall eat every tree which growth for you out of the field:

able to separate <u>45\_ROM\_08\_39</u> # Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

able to speak <u>42\_LUK\_01\_20</u># And, behold, thou shalt be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because thou believest not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season.

able to stand <u>09\_1SA\_06\_20</u># And the men of Bethshemesh said, Who is able to stand before this holy LORD God? and to whom shall he go up from us?

able to stand <u>05\_DEU\_07\_24</u> # And he shall deliver their kings into thine hand, and thou shalt destroy their name from under heaven: there shall no man be able to stand before thee, until thou have destroyed them.

able to stand <u>05\_DEU\_11\_25</u># There shall no man be able to stand before you: [for] the LORD your God shall lay the fear of you and the dread of you upon all the land that ye shall tread upon, as he hath said unto you.

able to stand 49\_EPH\_06\_11 # Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

able to stand <u>15 EZR 10 13 #</u> But the people [are] many, and [it is] a time of much rain, and we are not able to stand without, neither [is this] a work of one day or two: for we are many that have transgressed in this thing.

able to stand <u>18\_JOB\_41\_10</u># None [is so] fierce that dare stir him up: who then is able to stand before me?

able to stand <u>06\_JOS\_01\_05</u># There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, [so] I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

able to stand <u>06\_JOS\_23\_09</u> # For the LORD hath driven out from before you great nations and strong: but [as for] you, no man hath been able to stand before you unto this day.

able to stand 20\_PRO\_27\_04 # Wrath [is] cruel, and anger [is] outrageous; but who [is] able to stand before envy?

able to stand 66\_REV\_06\_17 # For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

able to succour <u>58\_HEB\_02\_18</u># For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

able to teach <u>55\_2TI\_02\_02</u> # And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

able to withstand <a href="#">14\_2CH\_20\_06</a># And said, O LORD God of our fathers, [art] not thou God in heaven? and rulest [not] thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand [is there not] power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee?

able to withstand 49 EPH 06 13 # Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

able utterly to 11 1KI 09 21 # Their children that were left after them in the land, whom the children of Israel also were not able utterly to destroy, upon those did Solomon levy a tribute of bondservice unto this day.

able with ten <u>42\_LUK\_14\_31</u># Or what king, going to make war against another king, sitteth not down first, and consulteth whether he be able with ten thousand to meet him that cometh against him with twenty thousand?

able <u>46\_1CO\_03\_02</u> # I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able [to bear it], neither yet now are ye able.

able <u>42\_LUK\_13\_24</u> # Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

able <u>40\_MAT\_20\_22</u># But Jesus answered and said, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of, and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

abominable and disobedient <u>56\_TIT\_01\_16</u># They profess that they know God; but in works they deny [him], being abominable, and disobedient, and unto every good work reprobate.

abominable and filthy <u>18\_JOB\_15\_16</u># How much more abominable and filthy [is] man, which drinketh iniquity like water?

abominable and murderers <u>66\_REV\_21\_08</u># But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

abominable beasts and <u>26\_EZE\_08\_10</u> # So I went in and saw; and behold every form of creeping things, and abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, portrayed upon the wall round about.

abominable branch and <u>23\_ISA\_14\_19</u># But thou art cast out of thy grave like an abominable branch, [and as] the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcase trodden under feet.

abominable flesh into <u>26\_EZE\_04\_14</u> # Then said I, Ah Lord GOD! behold, my soul hath not been polluted: for from my youth up even till now have I not eaten of that which dieth of itself, or is torn in pieces; neither came there abominable flesh into my mouth.

abominable idolatries <u>60\_1PE\_04\_03</u># For the time past of [our] life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, revellings, banquetings, and abominable idolatries:

abominable idols out <u>14\_2CH\_15\_08</u># And when Asa heard these words, and the prophecy of Oded the prophet, he took courage, and put away the abominable idols out of all the land of Judah and Benjamin, and out of the cities which he had taken from mount Ephraim, and renewed the altar of the LORD, that [was] before the porch of the LORD.

abominable iniquity there <u>19\_PSA\_53\_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

abominable it shall <u>03\_LEV\_19\_07</u># And if it be eaten at all on the third day, it [is] abominable; it shall not be accepted.

abominable than they <u>26\_EZE\_16\_52</u># Thou also, which hast judged thy sisters, bear thine own shame for thy sins that thou hast committed more abominable than they: they are more righteous than thou: yea, be thou confounded also, and bear thy shame, in that thou hast justified thy sisters.

abominable thing that <u>24\_JER\_44\_04</u> # Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending [them], saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate.

abominable thing 05\_DEU\_14\_03 # Thou shalt not eat any abominable thing.

abominable things is <u>23\_ISA\_65\_04</u> # Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable [things is in] their vessels;

abominable things <u>24\_JER\_16\_18</u># And first I will recompense their iniquity and their sin double; because they have defiled my land, they have filled mine inheritance with the carcases of their detestable and abominable things.

abominable to Joab <u>13\_1CH\_21\_06</u># But Levi and Benjamin counted he not among them: for the king's word was abominable to Joab.

abominable unclean thing <u>03\_LEV\_07\_21</u> # Moreover the soul that shall touch any unclean [thing, as] the uncleanness of man, or [any] unclean beast, or any abominable unclean [thing], and eat of the flesh of the sacrifice of peace offerings, which [pertain] unto the LORD, even that soul shall be cut off from his people.

abominable with any <u>03\_LEV\_11\_43</u># Ye shall not make yourselves abominable with any creeping thing that creepeth, neither shall ye make yourselves unclean with them, that ye should be defiled thereby.

abominable works there <u>19 PSA\_14\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, [there is] none that doeth good.

abominable <u>33\_MIC\_06\_10</u> # Are there yet the treasures of wickedness in the house of the wicked, and the scant measure [that is] abominable?

acceptable and perfect 45\_ROM\_12\_02 # And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

acceptable before God <u>54\_1TI\_05\_04</u># But if any widow have children or nephews, let them learn first to show piety at home, and to requite their parents: for that is good and acceptable before God.

acceptable being sanctified <u>45\_ROM\_15\_16</u> # That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

acceptable but the <u>20\_PRO\_10\_32</u># The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked [speaketh] frowardness.

acceptable day to 23\_ISA\_58\_05 # Is it such a fast that I have chosen? a day for a man to afflict his soul? [is it] to bow down his head as a bulrush, and to spread sackcloth and ashes [under him]? wilt thou call this a fast, and an acceptable day to the LORD?

acceptable for you <u>03\_LEV\_22\_20</u># [But] whatsoever hath a blemish, [that] shall ye not offer: for it shall not be acceptable for you.

acceptable in the 54\_1TI\_02\_03 # For this [is] good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

acceptable in thy 19\_PSA\_19\_14 # Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.

acceptable nor your <u>24\_JER\_06\_20</u> # To what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, and the sweet cane from a far country? your burnt offerings [are] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.

acceptable time have 23\_ISA\_49\_08 # Thus saith the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard thee, and in a day of salvation have I helped thee: and I will preserve thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, to establish the earth, to cause to inherit the desolate heritages;

acceptable time O 19\_PSA\_69\_13 # But as for me, my prayer [is] unto thee, O LORD, [in] an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation.

acceptable to God 60\_1PE\_02\_05 # Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.

acceptable to God <u>45\_ROM\_14\_18</u># For he that in these things serveth Christ [is] acceptable to God, and approved of men.

acceptable to his <u>05\_DEU\_33\_24</u> # And of Asher he said, [Let] Asher [be] blessed with children; let him be acceptable to his brethren, and let him dip his foot in oil.

acceptable to the <u>20\_PRO\_21\_03</u># To do justice and judgment [is] more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice.

acceptable unto God <u>45\_ROM\_12\_01</u> # I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, [which is] your reasonable service.

acceptable unto the 49\_EPH\_05\_10 # Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

acceptable unto thee <u>27\_DAN\_04\_27</u># Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.

acceptable wellpleasing to <u>50\_PHP\_04\_18</u> # But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things [which were sent] from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.

acceptable with God 60\_1PE\_02\_20 # For what glory [is it], if, when ye be buffeted for your faults, ye shall take it patiently? but if, when ye do well, and suffer [for it], ye take it patiently, this [is] acceptable with God.

acceptable words and <u>21\_ECC\_12\_10</u># The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and [that which was] written [was] upright, [even] words of truth.

acceptable year of <u>23\_ISA\_61\_02</u> # To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

acceptable year of 42\_LUK\_04\_19 # To preach the acceptable year of the Lord.

amiable are thy <u>19\_PSA\_84\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. How amiable [are] thy tabernacles, O LORD of hosts!

answerable to the <u>02\_EXO\_38\_18</u># And the hanging for the gate of the court [was] needlework, [of] blue, and purple, and scarlet, and fine twined linen: and twenty cubits [was] the length, and the height in the breadth [was] five cubits, answerable to the hangings of the court.

changeable suits of <u>23\_ISA\_03\_22</u># The changeable suits of apparel, and the mantles, and the wimples, and the crisping pins,

chargeable to any <u>53\_2TH\_03\_08</u># Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you:

chargeable to no <u>47\_2CO\_11\_09</u># And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].

chargeable unto any <u>52\_1TH\_02\_09</u># For ye remember, brethren, our labour and travail: for labouring night and day, because we would not be chargeable unto any of you, we preached unto you the gospel of God.

deceivableness of unrighteousness <u>53\_2TH\_02\_10</u> # And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

delectable things shall 23 ISA 44 09 # They that make a graven image [are] all of them vanity; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they [are] their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed.

desirable young men <u>26\_EZE\_23\_06</u># [Which were] clothed with blue, captains and rulers, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding upon horses.

desirable young men <u>26\_EZE\_23\_12</u> # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

desirable young men <u>26\_EZE\_23\_23</u># The Babylonians, and all the Chaldeans, Pekod, and Shoa, and Koa, [and] all the Assyrians with them: all of them desirable young men, captains and rulers, great lords and renowned, all of them riding upon horses.

detestable and abominable <u>24\_JER\_16\_18</u># And first I will recompense their iniquity and their sin double; because they have defiled my land, they have filled mine inheritance with the carcases of their detestable and abominable things.

detestable things and <u>26\_EZE\_05\_11</u># Wherefore, [as] I live, saith the Lord GOD; Surely, because thou hast defiled my sanctuary with all thy detestable things, and with all thine abominations, therefore will I also diminish [thee]; neither shall mine eye spare, neither will I have any pity.

detestable things and <u>26\_EZE\_11\_21</u># But [as for them] whose heart walketh after the heart of their detestable things and their abominations, I will recompense their way upon their own heads, saith the Lord

fables and endless <u>54\_1TI\_01\_04</u> # Neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in faith: [so do].

fables and exercise <u>54\_1TI\_04\_07</u> # But refuse profane and old wives' fables, and exercise thyself [rather] unto godliness.

fables when we 61\_2PE\_01\_16 # For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

fables <u>55\_2TI\_04\_04</u># And they shall turn away [their] ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables.

favourable no more 19\_PSA\_77\_07 # Will the Lord cast off for ever? and will he be favourable no more?

favourable unto him <u>18\_JOB\_33\_26</u># He shall pray unto God, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.

favourable unto them <u>07\_JUD\_21\_22</u># And it shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be favourable unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, [that] ye should be guilty.

favourable unto thy 19\_PSA\_85\_01 # To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. LORD, thou hast been favourable unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.

habitable part of <u>20\_PRO\_08\_31</u># Rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my delights [were] with the sons of men.

honourable among the 13\_1CH\_11\_25 # Behold, he was honourable among the thirty, but attained not to

the [first] three: and David set him over his guard.

honourable and glorious <u>19\_PSA\_111\_03</u># His work [is] honourable and glorious: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

honourable and I <u>23\_ISA\_43\_04</u># Since thou wast precious in my sight, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life.

honourable and shalt <u>23\_ISA\_58\_13</u># If thou turn away thy foot from the sabbath, [from] doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of the LORD, honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking [thine own] words:

honourable because by <u>12 2KI 05 01 # Now Naaman</u>, captain of the host of the king of Syria, was a great man with his master, and honourable, because by him the LORD had given deliverance unto Syria: he was also a mighty man in valour, [but he was] a leper.

honourable but we 46\_1CO\_04\_10 # We [are] fools for Christ's sake, but ye [are] wise in Christ; we [are] weak, but ye [are] strong; ye [are] honourable, but we [are] despised.

honourable counsellor which <u>41\_MAR\_15\_43</u> # Joseph of Arimathaea, an honourable counsellor, which also waited for the kingdom of God, came, and went in boldly unto Pilate, and craved the body of Jesus.

honourable he is <u>23\_ISA\_09\_15</u># The ancient and honourable, he [is] the head; and the prophet that teacheth lies, he [is] the tail.

honourable in all <u>58\_HEB\_13\_04</u> # Marriage [is] honourable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge.

honourable in thine <u>09\_1SA\_22\_14</u> # Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

honourable man all <u>09\_1SA\_09\_06</u># And he said unto him, Behold now, [there is] in this city a man of God, and [he is] an honourable man; all that he saith cometh surely to pass: now let us go thither; peradventure he can show us our way that we should go.

honourable man and <u>23\_ISA\_03\_03</u># The captain of fifty, and the honourable man, and the counsellor, and the cunning artificer, and the eloquent orator.

honourable than the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_21</u># Of the three, he was more honourable than the two; for he was their captain: howbeit he attained not to the [first] three.
