

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

absent am bold <u>47\_2CO\_10\_01</u> # Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence [am] base among you, but being absent am bold toward you:

absent from the <u>47\_2CO\_05\_06</u> # Therefore [we are] always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord:

absent from the <u>47\_2CO\_05\_08</u># We are confident, [I say], and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

absent I may <u>50\_PHP\_01\_27</u> # Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

absent in body <u>46\_1CO\_05\_03</u> # For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present, [concerning] him that hath so done this deed,

absent in the <u>51\_COL\_02\_05</u># For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

absent lest being 47\_2CO\_13\_10 # Therefore I write these things being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power which the Lord hath given me to edification, and not to destruction.

absent now I <u>47\_2CO\_13\_02</u># I told you before, and foretell you, as if I were present, the second time; and being absent now I write to them which heretofore have sinned, and to all other, that, if I come again, I will not spare:

absent one from <u>01\_GEN\_31\_49</u> # And Mizpah; for he said, The LORD watch between me and thee, when we are absent one from another.

absent such will <u>47\_2CO\_10\_11</u># Let such an one think this, that, such as we are in word by letters when we are absent, such [will we be] also in deed when we are present.

absent we may <u>47\_2CO\_05\_09</u> # Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.
