acknowledge and I 47 2CO 01 13 # For we write none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;

acknowledge and increase 27 DAN 11 39 # Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge [and] increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

acknowledge even to 47 2CO 01 13 # For we write none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;

acknowledge him and 20 PRO 03 06 # In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

acknowledge his brethren <u>05 DEU 33 09</u> # Who said unto his father and to his mother, I have not seen him; neither did he acknowledge his brethren, nor knew his own children: for they have observed thy word, and kept thy covenant.

acknowledge my might 23 ISA 33 13 # Hear, ye [that are] far off, what I have done; and, ye [that are] near, acknowledge my might.

acknowledge my transgressions 19 PSA 51 03 # For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin [is] ever before me.

acknowledge O LORD 24 JER 14 20 # We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, [and] the iniquity of our fathers; for we have sinned against thee.

acknowledge that the 46 1CO 14 37 # If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

acknowledge the son 05 DEU 21 17 # But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated [for] the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath: for he [is] the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn [is] his.

acknowledge their offence 28 HOS 05 15 #I will go [and] return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

acknowledge them that 23 ISA 61 09 # And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they [are] the seed [which] the LORD hath blessed.

acknowledge them that 24 JER 24 05 # Thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel; Like these good figs, so will I acknowledge them that are carried away captive of Judah, whom I have sent out of this place into the land of the Chaldeans for [their] good.

acknowledge thine iniquity 24 JER 03 13 # Only acknowledge thine iniquity, that thou hast transgressed against the LORD thy God, and hast scattered thy ways to the strangers under every green tree, and ye have not obeyed my voice, saith the LORD.

acknowledge us not 23 ISA 63 16 # Doubtless thou [art] our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, O LORD, [art] our father, our redeemer; thy name [is] from everlasting. acknowledge ye them 46 ICO 16 18 # For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.

acknowledged my sin 19 PSA 32 05 # I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.

acknowledged them and 01 GEN 38 26 # And Judah acknowledged [them], and said, She hath been more righteous than I; because that I gave her not to Shelah my son. And he knew her again no more.
