acknowledge and I [47\\_2CO\\_01\\_13](#) # For we write none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;

acknowledge and increase [27\\_DAN\\_11\\_39](#) # Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge [and] increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

acknowledge even to [47\\_2CO\\_01\\_13](#) # For we write none other things unto you, than what ye read or acknowledge; and I trust ye shall acknowledge even to the end;

acknowledge him and [20\\_PRO\\_03\\_06](#) # In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

acknowledge O LORD [24\\_JER\\_14\\_20](#) # We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, [and] the iniquity of our fathers: for we have sinned against thee.

acknowledge that the [46\\_ICO\\_14\\_37](#) # If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

acknowledge the son [05\\_DEU\\_21\\_17](#) # But he shall acknowledge the son of the hated [for] the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he hath: for he [is] the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn [is] his.

acknowledge their offence [28\\_HOS\\_05\\_15](#) # I will go [and] return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

acknowledge ye them [46\\_ICO\\_16\\_18](#) # For they have refreshed my spirit and yours: therefore acknowledge ye them that are such.

acknowledged my sin [19\\_PSA\\_32\\_05](#) # I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.
